

Most Holy Trinity Sunday

“The Feast of the Most Holy Trinity leads us to contemplate the mystery of God who unceasingly creates, redeems and sanctifies, always with love and through love.”

—Pope Francis, May 27, 2018



The mystery of the Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and life. God reveals himself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The doctrine of the Trinity includes three truths of faith.

First, the Trinity is One. We do not speak of three gods but of one God. Each of the Persons is fully God. They are a unity of Persons in one divine nature.

Second, the Divine Persons are distinct from each other. Father, Son, and Spirit are not three appearances or modes of God, but three identifiable persons, each fully God in a way distinct from the others.

Third, the Divine Persons are in relation to each other. The distinction of each is understood only in reference

to the others. The Father cannot be the Father without the Son, nor can the Son be the Son without the Father. The Holy Spirit is related to the Father and the Son who both send him forth.

All Christians are baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. The Trinity illumines all the other mysteries of faith.

Saint of the Week

Saint Ephrem, Deacon and Doctor of the Church

c. 306–373 | FEAST DAY JUNE 9

Known to Syrian Christians as “the harp of the Holy Ghost,” this Mesopotamian from Nisibia was baptized at 18 and may have accompanied his bishop to the Council of Nicaea in 325. He served as head of the cathedral school and left Nisibia only after it became Persian. In 363 he moved to a cave overlooking Edessa but preached frequently in the city and wrote many poems, hymns and biblical commentaries; he organized a choir of women to sing his hymns during liturgies. About 370 he visited St. Basil in Caesarea. The winter before his death, he earned praise for managing relief supplies during a severe famine in Edessa. Ephraem is the only Syrian father declared a doctor of the church.

Thank you for having responded to my call."

From a report of a parishioner's first pilgrimage to Medjugorje: "Finally the Pentecost sun arrived and peaked over the mountains at about 5:35 A.M. and was in full brilliance in minutes. I took several pictures. As I was moving to get another viewpoint, Barbara, one of the members of our group, who was standing at the base of the cross on Cross Mountain pointed to the sun and said quietly – "look at the sun". When I did, it appeared at first to be spinning and kind of pulsating. The best way I know how to describe it is if you can imagine the full sun in all its brightness and in front of it, a large disk, much like the large host which we have seen Father consecrate at Eucharist, masking all the sun behind it except for the outer circumference or ring of radiance, such that your eyes were protected from its full brilliance. The disk was gray in color to me and white to my wife. The "host" seemed to move over the sun at random from one side to another creating a sense of pulsation. The outer rings of the sun seemed to have rays extending outward a short distance and they appeared to spin. My wife saw a pink then a blue circle around the sun. We watched it for about 3 or 4 minutes and finally it returned to full brilliance and we stop watching. Both the mountain and its pilgrims were bathed in silence. Nobody seemed to want to say anything."


