Baptism: The celebration of Baptism is a moment of grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire parish community. Preparation class is required. Call the parish office for information.

First Communion and Confirmation: First Communion and Confirmation are yearlong programs that start in the fall. Please contact the parish office for information.

Confirmation for Adults: If you are a baptized Catholic and desire the Sacrament of Confirmation please contact the parish office.

Marriage: Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage and fulfill the pre-marriage process. The pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

Becoming Catholic: The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults includes all those interested in the Catholic faith. Call the office for information.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call the parish office if you or a member of your family need the Sacrament of Anointing.

Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity is celebrated on the first Sunday after Pentecost. This feast was instituted by Pope John XXII in 1334 and it became a Solemnity with the reforms of Vatican II. "Christians are baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit: not in their names, for there is only one God, the almighty Father, his only Son, and the Holy Spirit: The Most Holy Trinity." (CCC 233)

"The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God himself." (CCC 234)

The doctrine of the Trinity includes three truths of faith. First, the Trinity is One. Second, the Divine Persons are distinct from each other. Third, the Divine Persons are in relation to each other. All Christians are baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
