## SACRAMENTS

**Baptism:** The celebration of Baptism is a moment of grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire parish community. Preparation class is required. Call the parish office for information.

**First Communion and Confirmation:** First Communion and Confirmation are yearlong programs that start in the fall. Please contact the parish office for information.

**Confirmation for Adults:** If you are a baptized Catholic and desire the Sacrament of Confirmation please contact the parish office.

**Marriage:** Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage and fulfill the pre-marriage process. The pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

**Becoming Catholic:** The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults includes all those interested in the Catholic faith. Call the office for information.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Please call the parish office if you or a member of your family need the Sacrament of Anointing.

**After Hours Sick Calls:** In case of serious illness after hours, please call 850-897-7727 and leave a message. Messages are checked regularly.

## Fish Fry

The Knights of Columbus will host a Fish Fry on Friday, March 27, from 4pm to 7pm. in the Faith Formation Building. The Knights will serve fried or baked cod with three sides; grilled cheese sandwiches and tomato soup will also be available. ## KofC Scholarship
