SACRAMENTS

Baptism: The celebration of Baptism is a moment of grace for those to be baptized, for their families, and for the entire parish community. Preparation class is required. Call the parish office for information.

First Communion and Confirmation: First Communion and Confirmation are yearlong programs that start in the fall. Please contact the parish office for information.

Confirmation for Adults: If you are a baptized Catholic and desire the Sacrament of Confirmation please contact the parish office.

Marriage: Couples planning to be married must see a priest at least six months prior to the planned marriage and fulfill the pre-marriage process. The pastor will provide the couple with the guidelines and secure the date and time of the wedding. Do not set a date in advance until you have spoken to the pastor.

Becoming Catholic: The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults includes all those interested in the Catholic faith. Call the office for information.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call the parish office if you or a member of your family need the Sacrament of Anointing.

Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ also known as Corpus Christi—Latin for “Body of Christ.” The Solemnity calls attention to the Real Presence of Christ. When we consume the Blessed Sacrament, we consume the Body, Blood, Soul & Divinity of Jesus Christ. At the exposition and benediction during Adoration, we sing “O Salutaris Hostia” and “Tantum Ergo” which were written by Thomas Aquinas for the Feast of Corpus Christi.

Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

The Bishops of the United States voted to consecrate this nation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The consecration will take place on June 11th at their gathering in Orlando as a way to acknowledge the two hundred and fiftieth anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. What does this mean? Why consecrate the nation to the Sacred Heart?

Devotion to the Sacred Heart has developed over the centuries following the experiences of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque and the apparitions she witnessed in the seventeenth century. Popes have lauded the practice of consecration of the self, home, and even whole nations to the Sacred Heart. In his encyclical instituting the Solemnity of Christ the King, Pope Pius XI, drawing on the teaching of Pope Leo XIII, commanded the “pious custom” of consecrating the nation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus as a way to recognize the kingship of Christ. By celebrating this important national anniversary with this devotion, we have the opportunity to encourage all Catholics to honor our Lord and to “infuse the spirit of the Gospel into various communities and departments of life.”

Join Christ Our Redeemer as we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus on Thursday, June 11th at 8:30am. We will pray the prayer of consecration at the end of the Mass.
