

# THIS WEEK'S GOSPEL MEDITATION

GOSPEL: MARK 11:1-10



The Palm Sunday procession is formed of Christians who, in the "fullness of faith," make theirs, the gesture of the Jews and endow it with its full significance. Following the Jews' example, we proclaim Christ as a Victor... Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is He who comes in the Name of the Lord. But by our faith we know, as they did not, all that His triumph stands for. He is the Messiah, the Son of David and the Son of God. He is the sign of contradiction, acclaimed by some and reviled by others. Sent into this world to wrest us from sin and the power of Satan, He underwent His Passion, the punishment for our sins, but issues forth triumphant from the tomb, the victor over death, making our peace with God and taking us with Him into the kingdom of His Father in heaven

# **PALM SUNDAY**



We carry palm branches as a tribute of waving joy, Christ's victory over death.

As the faithful, we remember Christ's triumphal entrance

into Jerusalem on a donkey. In Jesus' time, a huge crowd assembled, put their cloaks or branches on the ground, and waved palm branches, acclaiming Christ as the King of Israel, the Son of David. We now wave our palm branches and sing as the priest enters the church:

Hosanna to the Son of David, the King of Israel. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.

These words of praise are echoed every day at the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, our joy is quickly subdued, we are jolted to reality and see the purpose of Christ coming to Jerusalem by the reading of the Passion at the Gospel.
