## What is a Mass Intention? Remembering Loved Ones

Have you noticed that every Mass said here at St. Michael is offered for a special intention? The entire congregation prays for that intention during the petitions (Prayers of the Faithful) when we say, "For those whom have died, and for the intention of this Mass: (name of who the intention is for)."

Masses are often offered for family, friends, and relatives that have died. Praying for the dead is a Spiritual Work of Mercy. Offering a Mass for someone who has died is an especially comforting gesture to the family. Mass can also be offered to commemorate joyful occasions and to give thanks to God for blessings received.

The suggested offering for a Mass is \$10 per intention. However, any amount that you would like to offer is acceptable. You may request a Mass intention by visiting the parish office during office hours or by calling 312-642-2498.

**Pastor's Note – Who is Jesus!**



In today’s Gospel, Jesus asks his disciples, “Who do the people say that I am?” This was a very important question for the disciples to answer because not all the people saw Jesus the same way. The disciples answered Jesus by saying that he was John the Baptist, or Elijah, or one of the prophets. In other words, they did not see him as

the Messiah who was to come, only the precursor of the Messiah, the one to announce that the Messiah was coming and to prepare the way. They saw Jesus as a prophet, as a miracle worker, a messenger of God, and a holy man, just not the Messiah. And because they did not see him as the Messiah, the people did not have to follow his teaching.

Then Jesus turned the question to his disciples, and Peter answered for the disciples that he is “the Christ, the Son of the Living God.” He sees Jesus as the anointed one of God and the Son of God. It seems that they finally understand. They had been following Jesus for almost three years, and it began to sink in. Of course, it did not last because they still had their ideas of what the Messiah should do. The idea that he should go to Jerusalem and die was out of the question. They knew that he was the Messiah, but they did not realize what that would mean for Jesus or themselves.

Taking that question on ourselves, we need to ask who Jesus is for each of us individually. The way we answer that question will determine how we see Jesus acting in our lives, how we act toward him, and what we are expecting from him now and in the future. Do we see him around us every day or only on Sunday? Do we see him as the Savior who died to save us and assure our place in heaven, but does not do much for us now? Do you answer his love by loving your neighbors or only your family and friends? We can’t just answer, as Peter did, that he is our savior. We need to look at what our answer really means and how it will affect our lives.

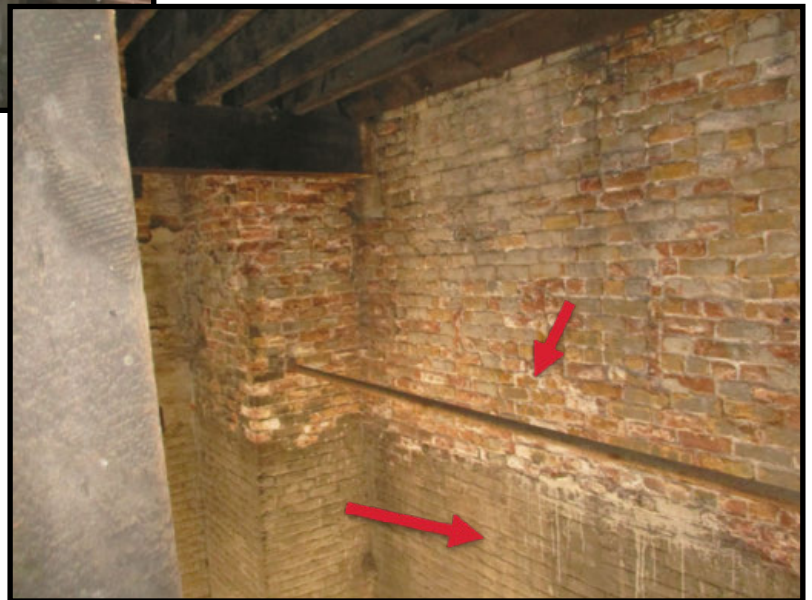

Bottom 4' of shingles replaced in 2011. Shingles above the snow guard are 38 years old and past their effective life span. Brittle and starting to break apart and fall off the roof regularly.

Lighting protection cable. Approximately 45 years old and past effective lifespan.

West Elevation (Tower) - view of the interior brick masonry directly below the belfry level. The parge coating installed in 1997 has spalled off the wall. ## CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

### St. Paul Conversion

#### Question:

January 25 is the feast of the Conversion of St. Paul and the end of the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. What does one have to do with the other?

#### Answer:

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity consists of eight days beginning January 18 (at that time the feast of the Chair of Peter), and ending on January 25, the feast of the Conversion of St. Paul. The Franciscan Friars of the Atonement, founded in the early twentieth century in Graymoor, NY, sought to promote unity among Anglicans and Roman Catholics. Paul James Wattson, a former Episcopalian priest, founded the community, which was formally accepted into the Catholic communion.

The idea for Christian unity soon began to catch on, and by the 1930s, more and more Christians welcomed such a focus. Suggestions for prayer and education are distributed each year, emphasizing a jointly chosen theme. The 1964 Vatican II document on ecumenism, *Unitatis Redintegratio*, gave a great boost to the octave, so that today many Christians worldwide promote and participate in the octave time of prayer.

The emphasis on both Peter and Paul aptly fits into the rationale of the octave. Peter is seen as the source of unity within the Christian tradition. Paul is highlighted due to his vision of bringing all to Christ. The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is an ideal opportunity to pray for and promote respect, understanding, and, hopefully, eventual unity among Christians. 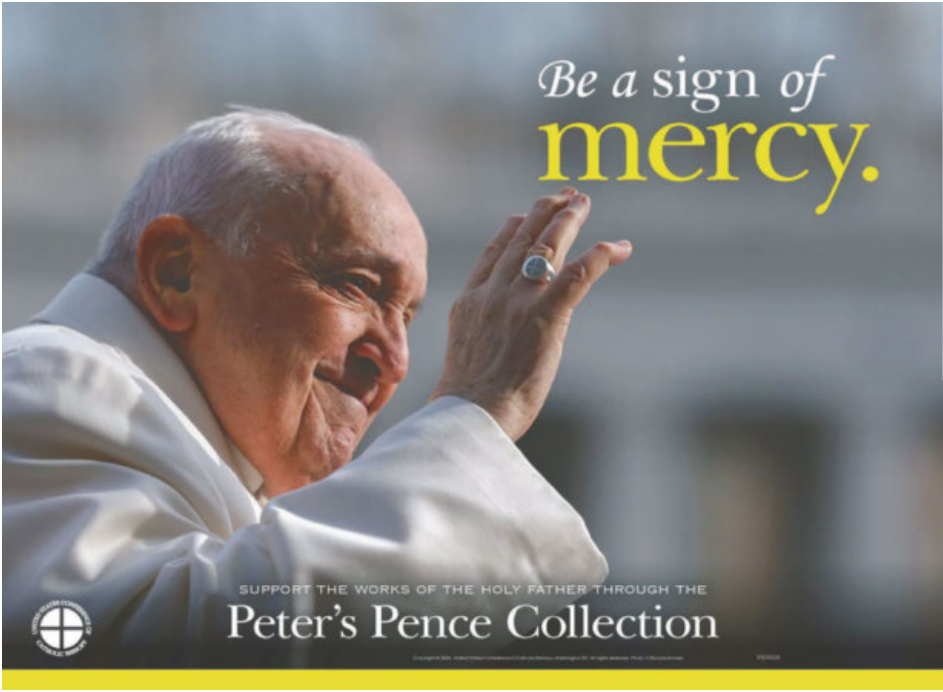

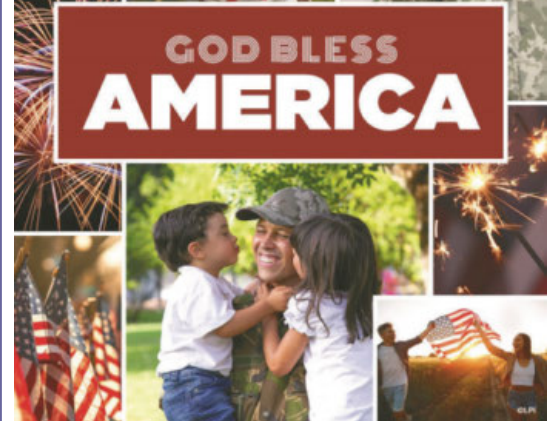


