## Pastor's Note – Call to Discipleship



In today's Gospel, Jesus is sending his disciples out to prepare the people of the towns he was going to visit. These "front men" were to get the people ready for Jesus. It seems strange that he would send them out without preparation or fancy speeches. He did not give them talking points or tell them how they were to advertise his arrival. He just sent them out and told them to tell the people that the Kingdom of God was at hand.

As disciples, we are called not to focus on the message; the Holy Spirit will take care of that, we need to get ourselves out and spread the "good news." The people are ready to hear the news; what is lacking are the messengers. As Jesus put it, "The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few." We are called to be the disciples that Jesus is sending out. It is through our act of going out and trusting in Jesus that we spread the Gospel. It is through our actions, our trust in God's providence, that people will see the Gospel working in our lives and receive the message.

The disciples went out without anything except the message of the kingdom. They were able to return rejoicing after a great success. We have the same message to share. Let us trust God and answer the call to discipleship by sharing the Gospel with our lives.

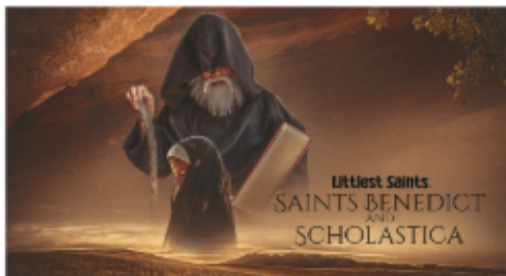
