

DAILY ITINERARY

☆March 9, Monday, Day 1: DEPART FROM USA

We depart on an overnight flight from Dallas Airport to Toulouse, France. Dinner and breakfast are served on the plane. Quotes for add-on flights and optional Premium Economy and Business Class upgrades are available upon request. Due to group air restrictions, we are not able to request specific seats on the flights. If seat selection is an important feature for you, please purchase your own airline tickets and buy a land only package from us.

TMarch 10, Tuesday, Day 2: TOULOUSE - LOURDES

Welcome to France! Your English-speaking tour managers will meet the group at the airport and assist with the bus boarding. Upon arrival, we visit Toulouse, the third largest city in France, with its many cafes, museums, and cathedrals. Here, St. Dominic founded the "Order of Preachers" in 1215. We visit the tomb of St. Thomas Aquinas at the Jacobins Church and have time in its peaceful cloister before we celebrate Mass. Following leisure time for lunch, we drive to Lourdes and settle into our hotel within walking distance of the Shrine of Our Lady. Dinner is at the hotel and we take part in the evening procession. (D)

다March 11 & 12, Wednesday & Thursday, Days 3 & 4: LOURDES

We are blessed to have two full days of pilgrimage in Lourdes, including daily Mass, watching the video presentation about the story of Lourdes, exploring the birthplace of St. Bernadette, and visiting the places associated with her life. We pray at the Stations of the Cross and drink the water from the miraculous spring. and get submerged in the healing waters of the baths. In the evening, join the Candlelight Procession at the Shrine. Overnight in Lourdes. (B.D)

After breakfast, we board our motorcoach and head to Loyola where we have a tour to see St. Ignatius's childhood home. The tour culminates with Mass and a private visit to the room where Ignatius experienced his spiritual conversion. We visit the basilica adjacent to the castle—together forming much of the Sanctuary of Loyola. In the afternoon, we travel to the Hermitage of Olatz and to Aranzazu, a popular shrine to Our Lady, where St. Ignatius prayed for strength to overcome his former temptations. Dinner and overnight in Loyola. (B.D)

¹ March 14, Saturday, Day 6: LOYOLA - SEGOVIA - AVILA

Early this morning, we depart for Segovia, the city of St. John of the Cross. We celebrate Mass at the magnificent Cathedral and explore Segovia. Here, St. Teresa founded her ninth order. We see the burial place of Saint John of the Cross, a friend of Saint Teresa, a theological scholar, and one of the greatest poets of the Spanish language. Here are also the bodily remains of Saint Domingo of Guzman, founder of the Dominican Order to whom the Catholic Church historically attributes the creation of the holy rosary. We visit Alcazar, the royal place built in the 11th century where Queen Isabel agreed to fund Christopher Columbus' exploration. Stroll through the Old Quarter of Segovia, seeing the Roman Aqueduct and Cathedral. After our visit to Segovia we proceed to Avila, the city of Kings and Saints and the birthplace of St. Teresa. Check into the hotel and enjoy dinner and overnight in Avila. (B.D)

ਊMarch 15, Sunday, Day 7: AVILA, THE SAINT'S HOMETOWN

We have the entire day in Avila to see the magnificent walled city dedicated to St. Teresa of Avila. Here, the atmosphere has changed very little since the days of St. Teresa, the great mystic and the first woman to be named a Doctor of the Church. We will visit the crypt of La Santa Convent, built on the site of the house where she was born; La Encarnacion Monastery, where St. Teresa became a nun and home to the most comprehensive museum dedicated to her life; the Cathedral and the Cuatro Postes (four columns) which commemorates the place where St. Teresa, at the age of seven convinced her brother to run away with her to die as martyrs in the land of the Moors. Their uncle caught them at this site, Cuatro Postes, and returned them home. You will be able to see the majestic city walls, by which Teresa walked daily as a child. We celebrate Mass in Avila. Dinner and overnight in Avila. (B.D)

We have a full-day excursion to Alba de Tormes to see the tomb of St. Teresa of Avila at the Basilica of St. Teresa and the nearby Convent of the Annunciation founded by St. Teresa, which includes a museum dedicated to her work, and also houses her incorrupt heart and her left arm. We also visit the Church of San Juan de la Cruz, the first church in the world dedicated to Saint John of the Cross. Following Mass and time for lunch and shopping, we return to Avila for dinner and overnight. (B.D)

☆ March 17, Tuesday, Day 9: MADRID

After breakfast, we board our motorcoach and head to Madrid. Upon arrival, we have a 90-minute walking tour of the city center. Following lunch in a local restaurant, we visit Monasterio de las Descalzas Reales (Monastery of the Barefoot Royals), home to a community of Poor Clare nuns. This gem housed in a Renaissance palace is famous for its art and religious artifacts. Here we see the monastery's incredible art collection, which includes works by famous artists like Titian and Van Dyck. The nuns still live here, and we have a guided tour. We celebrate Mass in Madrid. Dinner is at leisure tonight with an opportunity to taste local food. Overnight Madrid. (B)

다 March 18, Wednesday, Day 10: OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE

We depart our hotel in Madrid, driving south to the small village of Guadalupe, where we see the image of the dark-skinned Madonna in the Monastery of the St. Mary of Guadalupe. Despite the remarkable similarities of their origin stories, Spain and Mexico's respective Guadalupes are rarely mentioned together. St. Pope John Paul II brought the Spanish Guadalupe into the spotlight in 1982 when he became the first pope to visit the monastery, where her image is kept. There, he made a surprising confession. "The great esteem I have for the Virgin of Guadalupe of Mexico is unquestionable," the pope said. "But I realize that her origins are here. I should have come here before going to the Tepeyac Basilica to understand Mexican devotion better." We visit the church and celebrate Mass in this sacred spot. Return to Madrid for dinner and overnight. (B.D)

☆ March 19, Thursday, Day 11: MADRID

We start the day with a visit to the Almudena Cathedral, near the Royal palace dedicated to the Virgin of Almudean, the Patron Saint of Madrid, where we celebrate Mass. Our next stop is the Royal Palace of Madrid (Palacio Real) and the Royal Chapel of St. Anthony of La Florida. We tour the palace and visit the chapel, a hidden gem with beautiful frescoes by Goya, where we see the artist's tomb. The rest of the day is at leisure to explore Madrid on your own, get tickets to the Prado or another world-class museum in Madrid. Tonight we have a farewell dinner in a local restaurant. Overnight in Madrid. (B. Special Dinner)

After breakfast, we are transferred to the airport for our flight home. (B)

OPTIONAL EXTENSION TO ROME:

[†] March 20, Friday, Day 12: MADRID - ROME

Following breakfast, we check out of the hotel and are transferred to Madrid airport for a flight to Rome. Our first stop is St. Paul Outside the Walls, where we celebrate Mass. Nearby, we see the Tre Fontane Convent, where St. Paul was beheaded, and Our Lady of Revelation Shrines. Check into the hotel for dinner and overnight. (B.D)

☆March 21, Saturday, Day 13: VATICAN TREASURES

Following an early breakfast, we drive to St. Peter's Basilica for an early morning Mass and a visit to St. Peter's Basilica for a guided tour. The Basilica was built on the site where St. Peter, the first Pope and Bishop of Rome, was martyred. Here, we view Michelangelo's Pieta and pray at the tombs of St. Peter and Pope St. John Paul II. We walk past Castel Gandolfo over the Bridge of Angels to Piazza Navona, where we see the magnificent fountains by Bernini. Next is a visit to Santa Maria Sopra Minerva, the resting place of St. Catherine of Siena and the Pantheon. The rest of the day is at leisure to explore Rome on our own, perhaps visit the nearby Trevi Fountain and the Spanish Steps. Dinner is at leisure tonight, with the opportunity to taste some great Italian food in local restaurants. Overnight in Rome. (B)

TMarch 22, Sunday, Day 14: CHRISTIAN ROME

This morning, we visit the Basilica of St. John the Lateran and the Holy Stairs. This Basilica is where the Pope is installed and officiates as the Bishop of Rome. Next, we cross the street to visit the Holy Stairs. Tradition states that this staircase is from Pontius Pilate's palace of Jerusalem during the time of Jesus. It is also said that this staircase was brought to Rome by St. Helen in the 4th century. We may climb the steps on our knees to remember Christ's agonizing Passion. We walk over to the nearby Basilica di Santa Croce in Gerusalemme, where we see the relics of the True Cross. We proceed to the Basilica of St. Mary Major to conclude our day. This Basilica contains a relic from the Infant Jesus. We celebrate Mass at St. Mary Major. Tonight, enjoy a farewell dinner in a local restaurant. Overnight in Rome. (B. Special dinner)

¹ March 23, Monday, Day 15: RETURN TO USA

After breakfast, we are transferred to the airport for our flight home. (B)

Group Air:

Select International Tours is a tour company that specializes in group travel. A group is ten or more people traveling together. For each group we negotiate and secure group air contracts with all major airlines departing from the designated airport. This enables us to keep all passengers within a group traveling together, in most cases utilizing best air rates.

Group air contracts differ from individually purchased airline tickets in many ways. When group air contracts are negotiated, we deposit a certain number of seats to hold the space and GTD the rate. Unused seats must be released at least 90 days prior to departure to avoid a \$ 100.00 per unused seat penalty.

It is important to receive your registration by the deadline stated on the flyer. Once the seats are released back to the airlines, we may be able to accommodate passengers at a different air rate or on a different airline.

Group air contracts limit types of deviations allowed and in some cases issuing tickets at individual rates may be necessary. Individual rates & reservations are not GTD until the tickets are issued. In order to issue an individual ticket we must receive full payment. Taxes and fuel costs are subject to change until the tickets are issued.

Domestic add-on tickets:

We can assist you with domestic air to connect with our international group air if you wish. Indicate on the registration form which airport you wish us to research air from. We are not responsible for fees or charges incurred in case dates change or the trip is cancelled. However, when buying a domestic add-on ticket through Select we may be able to assist in case of changes.

We will provide you with best schedule to connect with the flight (we are not able to help you with tickets that do not connect directly to the international flight) and the best price we can offer. Our information will be sent to you by e-mail. We require an acceptance within 24 hours of our offer along with full payment otherwise the rate is subject to change based on availability. We cannot quote any domestic air requests more than twice.

Business Class and Economy Plus Seats:

We are happy to assist you with business class and economy plus seats. Passengers must be registered on one of our trips to receive a quote. We will quote the available rate which is subject to change until we receive payment to purchase the seats. Usually Economy Plus Seats require the group tickets to be issued before the ability to upgrade.

Passport and Visa information:

All airlines require us to submit valid passport information including full name (first, middle and last), date of birth, gender, country, in which your passport has been issued and passport expiration date. To ensure that we can provide this information accurately, we require a photo copy of each person's passport traveling on each tour. Your passport must be valid 6 months from the trip return date. It is the passenger's responsibility to check if visas are required for the destinations visited and to obtain any necessary travel documents. Select International Tours does not provide information or assistance about passports or visa requirements.

Frequent Flyer Numbers:

Select International cannot assist if you wish to reserve air using FF miles. We can update your record with Frequent Flyer #'s only if you note the number on the registration form. Otherwise please call the airline directly.

Seat Requests & Seat Changes

Select International Tours DOES NOT provide assistance with passenger's seating

preferences or specific seat requests. Due to the large number of passengers we work with, we are unable to provide this service unless the request is due to a medical issue. In this case, we will request a seat with the airline but cannot guarantee that the seat will be confirmed. Please understand that although requests are being made directly with the airline, not every request is guaranteed or granted by the airline. If you would like to have a seat number assigned, it is best to contact the airline directly upon receipt of your ticket confirmation # or change your seats at the time of check-in at the airport prior to departure.

"Land Only" (not purchasing group air with Select International Tour Package:

We understand that some passengers may wish to purchase their own air transportation. Arranging transportation on your own may give you the ability to use flight miles for your ticket, secure the seat you desire/require, or deviate from the group. We offer land only prices on all our tours.

Airport transfers are not provided for passengers purchasing land only (not purchasing air with us) if arriving or departing at any time different from the group. If you wish to enjoy the benefit of the group transfer, please be sure you are at the airport at the same time as the group. On certain itineraries airport transfers, may be very costly as the group may be traveling a far distance from the airport on the first or last day.

If the flight schedule you purchase arrives or departs at a time different from the group, it is your responsibility to join the group either at the airport or at the first hotel.

Flight cancellations or delays:

In case your flight is cancelled or delayed please work with the airline directly at the airport to be rebooked on the first available flight out. Your travel documents will contain an emergency number and the guide's phone. Any incurred costs are out of pocket and not included in the trip cost. The cost of private transfers in case of delays are not covered as part of your trip cost. You may file a claim with your Travel Protection Insurance company or with the airlines upon your return. Receipts will be required.

Single rooms:

A limited number of single rooms are available on each trip. If you wish to share a room let us know at the time of registration. We will attempt to connect you with another person looking to share. The cost of Travel Protection insurance will be adjusted to reflect the single supplement as insurance cost depends on total trip cost. Should we not be able to accommodate all single room requests and you are not able or willing to share, a complete refund will be provided.

If your roommate cancels, and the room is converted into single usage, a single supplement will be charged.

How much walking will there be on this trip?

This active program covers a good amount of ground each day. The days are busy, usually starting with a wake -up call around 7AM and departure by 9AM or earlier. We aim to be back at the hotel between 5PM and 6PM. Times may vary depending on destination and program.

Expect from three to four hours walking on some touring days. The pace is moderate, however you will encounter some uneven surfaces, stairs, steps, cobblestones, and significant slopes. Some tours require walking in the open air with no shade and no seating available.
