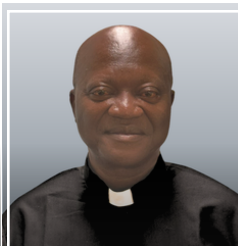

Divine Mercy Sunday

On this Divine Mercy Sunday, the Church invites us to contemplate the very heart of God: a heart that does not condemn but heals; does not reject, but restores. In the Gospel, the Risen Christ appears to His disciples, fearful, ashamed, and scattered, and His first words are not reproach, but peace: "Peace be with you." He then breathes on them and gives them the power to forgive sins. Mercy is not an afterthought in Christianity; it is its very center.

Pope Francis often reminded us, "The name of God is mercy." This is not merely a poetic phrase, it is a theological truth. God reveals Himself not primarily through power or judgment, but through His willingness to meet us in our brokenness and lift us up. Yet, if we are honest, mercy does not come easily to us. Our world is quick to judge. We label people, place them in boxes, and define them by their worst moments. Social media amplifies this tendency, but it is not new. The human heart has always struggled with impatience, with harshness, with the desire to be right rather than to be compassionate. The readings today challenge us to a different way of living. In Acts, the early Christian community is marked by unity, generosity, and mutual care. They do not see each other as categories, but as brothers and sisters. In 1 Peter, we are reminded that we have been given "a new birth into a living hope," a hope that is rooted not in our perfection, but in God's mercy. Divine Mercy calls us to pause before we judge, to put ourselves in another person's shoes, and to remember that every person carries a story we do not fully know. As the spiritual writer Henri Nouwen once reflected, compassion means "to suffer with." It requires us to enter into the reality of another, rather than stand at a distance and pass verdict. But mercy does not mean ignoring wrongdoing or pretending that everything is acceptable. True mercy sees clearly. It acknowledges sin and brokenness, but refuses to reduce a person to those realities. Justice and mercy are not opposed; they belong together. Justice without mercy becomes harsh and cold. Mercy without justice becomes shallow and sentimental. In God, the two meet perfectly. When Jesus shows His wounds to Thomas, He does not erase the marks of suffering. Instead, those wounds become the very place of faith. So too in our lives: mercy does not erase the past, but transforms it.

This Divine Mercy Sunday, let us ask for the grace to receive God's mercy deeply, and then to extend it generously. In a world quick to condemn, may we be slow to judge, rich in understanding, and bold in love. For in showing mercy, we reflect the very face of God.

Domingo de la Divina Misericordia

En este Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, la Iglesia nos invita a contemplar el corazón mismo de Dios: un corazón que no condena, sino que sana; que no rechaza, sino que restaura. En el Evangelio, Cristo Resucitado se aparece a sus discípulos, temerosos, avergonzados y dispersos, y sus primeras palabras no son de reproche, sino de paz: «La paz esté con ustedes». Luego sopla sobre ellos y les concede el poder de perdonar los pecados. La misericordia no es un añadido en el cristianismo; es su centro mismo.

El papa Francisco nos recordaba con frecuencia: «El nombre de Dios es misericordia». Esta no es simplemente una frase poética, sino una verdad teológica. Dios se revela a sí mismo no principalmente a través del poder o del juicio, sino a través de su disposición a encontrarnos en nuestra fragilidad y levantarnos. Sin embargo, si somos honestos, la misericordia no nos resulta fácil. Nuestro mundo es rápido para juzgar. Etiquetamos a las personas, las colocamos en categorías y las definimos por sus peores momentos. Las redes sociales amplifican esta tendencia, pero no es algo nuevo. El corazón humano siempre ha luchado con la impaciencia, con la dureza, con el deseo de tener la razón en lugar de ser compasivo. Las lecturas de hoy nos desafían a un modo de vivir diferente. En los Hechos de los Apóstoles, la primera comunidad cristiana se caracteriza por la unidad, la generosidad y el cuidado mutuo. No se ven unos a otros como categorías, sino como hermanos y hermanas. En la primera carta de Pedro, se nos recuerda que hemos sido engendrados de nuevo para una «esperanza viva», una esperanza que no se fundamenta en nuestra perfección, sino en la misericordia de Dios.

La Divina Misericordia nos llama a hacer una pausa antes de juzgar, a ponernos en el lugar del otro y a recordar que cada persona lleva consigo una historia que no conocemos del todo. Como reflexionó el escritor espiritual Henri Nouwen, la compasión significa «sufrir con». Nos exige entrar en la realidad del otro, en lugar de permanecer a distancia y dictar sentencias. Pero la misericordia no significa ignorar el mal o fingir que todo es aceptable. La verdadera misericordia ve con claridad.

Reconoce el pecado y la fragilidad, pero se niega a reducir a una persona a esas realidades. La justicia y la misericordia no se oponen; pertenecen juntas. La justicia sin misericordia se vuelve dura y fría. La misericordia sin justicia se vuelve superficial y sentimental. En Dios, ambas se encuentran perfectamente. Cuando Jesús muestra sus heridas a Tomás, no borra las huellas del sufrimiento. Por el contrario, esas heridas se convierten en el lugar mismo de la fe. Así también en nuestras vidas: la misericordia no borra el pasado, sino que lo transforma.

En este Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, pidamos la gracia de acoger profundamente la misericordia de Dios y luego extenderla generosamente. En un mundo rápido para condenar, que seamos lentos para juzgar, ricos en comprensión y audaces en el amor. Porque al mostrar misericordia, reflejamos el mismo rostro de Dios.
