

## **Patrol Rules and Expectations**

- #1. Be on time:  
A.M. Duty – be in the patrol area no later than 7:35 am.  
P.M. Duty – be in the patrol area no later than 2:25 pm.
- #2. Never leave your assigned area (unless there is an emergency)
- #3. Use patrol equipment appropriately.
- #4. Always be standing and alert while on duty.
- #5. Serve your entire week of duty.  
A sub may only be obtained for a legitimate reason (appointment, illness, out of town, etc.)  
You should find your own sub when possible.  
Inform the patrol supervisor who your sub will be.  
If you are ill, a parent/guardian must call the office by 7:25 a.m. to inform the school that you will be absent and a patrol sub is needed.
- #6. No socializing while on duty.
- #7. A vest must be worn correctly while on duty.
- #8. Patrols are expected to dress appropriately for the weather. Boots, hats, mittens, warm jackets are required in winter months. Ponchos must be worn in rain.
- #9. Patrols must have acceptable grades and effort.
- #10. Follow behavior guidelines set in the Student Handbook. Model respectful behavior at all times.

## **Consequences**

Not fulfilling any of the above stated rules and expectations constitutes an infraction. Students have the responsibility to inform parents of infractions they committed. Upon the third infraction, the student will be relieved of patrol duties. Parents will be informed of that decision in a letter sent home.
