Easter is one of the great solemnities of the Christian tradition. Easter day is celebrated for eight days in the Church's calendar. The eight days symbolizes the completion of a cycle of the new creation. The first creation is done in seven stages in Genesis and the new creation, where Christ comes to not only restore things to their correct way of being, but to make them better, that new creation occurs on the 8th day, the Sunday, the day after the Sabbath rest. creation is made new. Symbolically, Easter Sunday now is like an 8th day of creation ushering a new creation where the world is reconciled to God the Father and we human beings are made adopted children in the family of the Blessed Trinity.

A little about the Annual Appeal

I'm not a big fan of talking about money, however, sometimes we need to. Our Diocesan Annual Appeal goal was set at \$70,000 so far thanks to your generosity we have gotten pledges of \$52,000. The goal however isn't really a goal, it is a bill to the parish for the work the Diocese does. This includes Catholic Charities, educating seminarians, and support of the various offices of the Diocese. It is a necessary collection for the Diocese and each parish is obligated to help contribute. Some people tell me they are willing to support St. Francis, but not the Diocese. The best way to support the parish is by pledging some of your parish support to the Annual Appeal. Our own goal is to give

to the Annual Appeal 25% above the amount set by the Diocese. The reason for that is the monies over the Annual Appeal amount come back to the parish and are not taxed by the Diocese. The Diocese supports itself through the Annual Appeal and through a tax on parish income. However, the parish rebate (the amount given over the Annual Appeal target) is not taxed as income. Therefore, the best way to support the parish is to give generously to the Annual Appeal.

Thank you, again, to all who helped make the Holy Week and Easter celebrations come together to be meaningful and enjoyable. A personal thank you, as well, to the many people who sent me cards, gifts, candy, and well wishes at Easter. It is greatly appreciated.
