

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER OLSON

Dear Parishioners and Friends:

Looking ahead to the month of June here is a little overview from a Catholic webpage:

The beginning of the June falls within the liturgical season of Easter, which is represented by the liturgical color white — the color of light, a symbol of joy and innocence (absolute or restored in baptism). The remainder of the month falls within the liturgical season of Ordinary Time, which is represented by the liturgical color green. This symbol of hope is the color of the sprouting seed and arouses in the faithful the hope of reaping the eternal harvest of heaven, especially the hope of a glorious resurrection. It is used in the offices and Masses of Ordinary Time.

Following Pentecost, June 5th, the Church begins her slow descent from

Sunday, May 29 8:30am Mass +Harry Mark 10:30am Mass St. Francis Parish the great peaks of the Easter Season to the verdant pastures of Ordinary Time, the longest of the liturgical seasons. She pauses briefly, to praise the Holy Trinity — Creator, Redeemer, and Sanctifier; and then the Sacrament of the Body and Blood of Christ, Corpus Christi. Like the lush June growth all around us, the green of the liturgical season points to the new life won for us by the Redemption of Jesus Christ, the new life of Charity. For Our Lord came to cast the fire of His love on the earth, and to that end, sent His Holy Spirit at Pentecost in the form of tongues of fire.

Here are some of the highlights in the month of June:

June 5 Pentecost – the coming of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles in the form of tongues of fire and wind. It marks the public pronouncement of the Church by the Apostles. We will celebrate here with Potluck and Kickball and a birthday cake for the Church.

June 12 The Most Holy Trinity – The great mystery of the of God as Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The Three Persons in One God, each of whom is God while God remains only One.

June 13 The Memorial of St. Anthony

of Padua. He has become the keeper of the heavenly lost and found. In his day he was considered a great preacher and nicknamed "the hammer of heretics." A perennially favorite saint for those of us who mislay things from time to time.

June 19 Corpus Christi – The celebration of the Body and Blood of Christ. It is a time to renew our own belief in the reality of the Presence of Christ in the Eucharist.

June 25 On this Saturday, there will be two new priests ordained for the Diocese of La Crosse.

June 27 is the feast of St. Cyril of Alexandria, a great defender of the divinity of Christ and the right of Mary to be called the Mother of God. It is also the 24th anniversary of my own ordination to the priesthood.

June 29 The Feast of Saints Peter and Paul marks the importance of the city of Rome where both of these pillars of the Church were martyred.
