

As I consider the wide range of experiences many of us have gone through this year, I am drawn to the Apostle Paul's word to the church in Philippi when he writes, "I know what it is to have little, and I know what it is to have plenty. In all circumstances I have learned the secret of being well-fed and of going hungry of having plenty and of being in need." (Philippians 4:12) This verse comes shortly after his inviting others to "not worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God." (Philippians 4:6)

PANCAKE BREAKFASTS ON HOLD

Due to a change in Dept. of Public Instruction policy, our Knights of Columbus Pancake Breakfasts have been put on hold. Because they are held in the school's commercial kitchen we must comply by DPI rules and state and county inspections, which requires that a certified person must be present when using the commercial kitchen. It was decided to put a pause on the pancake breakfasts until we have a process to ensure compliance is in place. 
