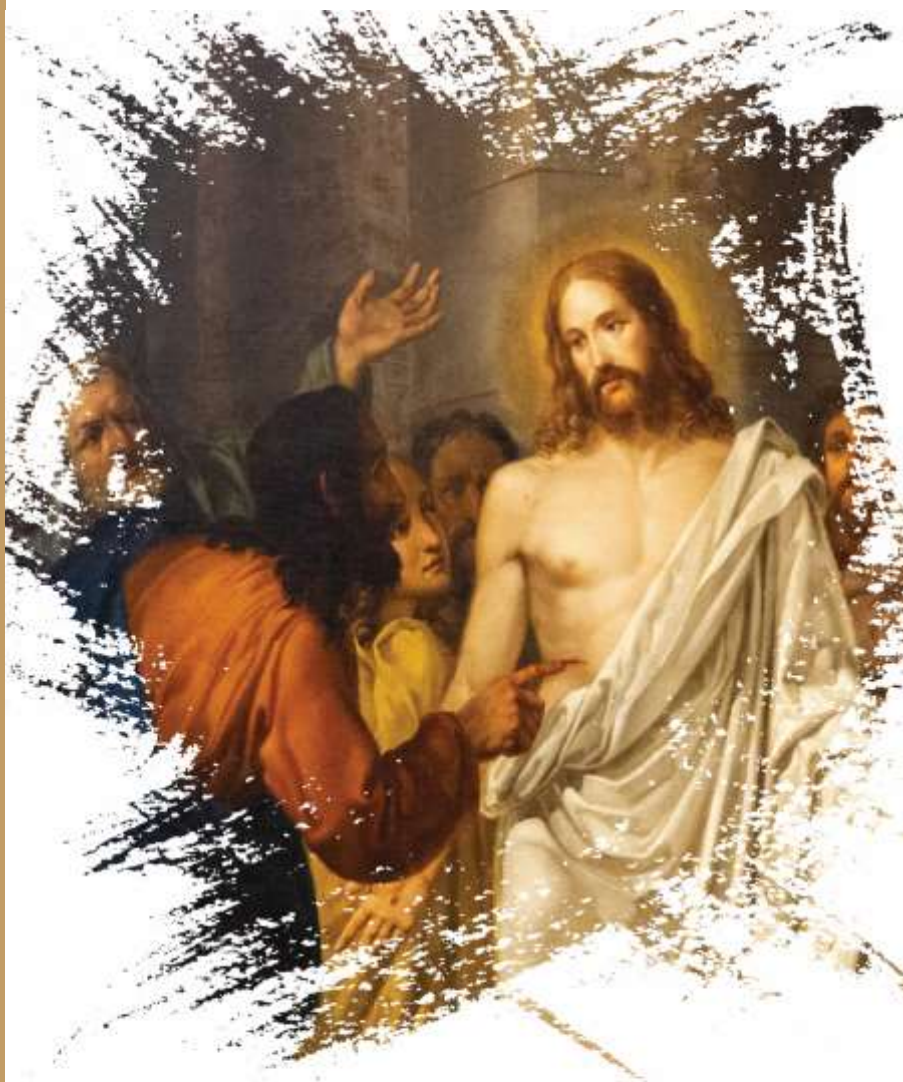

Christ is risen. Life will get very interesting for us too, when we stop unbelieving and believe!
