



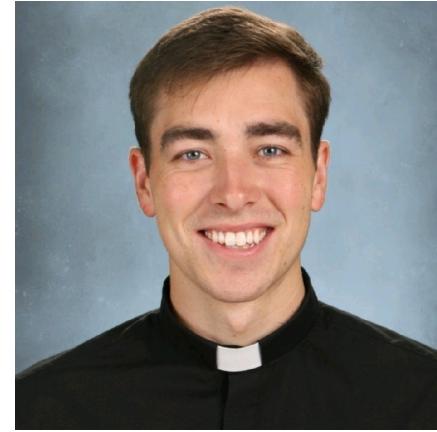
COR CHRISTI INSTITUTE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MARY
