


### **How to Submit Mass Intentions**

# Pray in memory of All our dear departed

St. Ignatius Parish continues to monitor the novel coronavirus illness as changes develop, and staff are following guidance and updates from the San Francisco Department of Health. At this time, risk remains minimal to the public in our local community. Regular and vigorous handwashing is the most effective way to remain healthy from similar illnesses, as is getting a flu shot.

During our celebration of the liturgy at St. Ignatius, please feel free to refrain from holding hands during prayer or grasping hands during the passing of the peace at Mass, if this is more comfortable for you. In addition, please note we have suspended taking Communion from the Cup, and we are asking those who traditionally take Communion on the tongue to receive in their hand to further minimize the possibility of transmission.

### Dear Sisters and Brothers -

I'd like to give you a few updates on our music program. First, I have hired Brian DuSell, husband of Teresa, to be the acting Director of Music at St. Ignatius. Brian, the USF Associate Director for Liturgy, Music and Interfaith Programs, is an accomplished musician and director, with many years of experience in liturgical music. He will be with us through Pentecost, May 31. I am very grateful for his interest and generosity, which will help keep this transition as smooth as possible.

Second, I am beginning the process of hiring a new Director of Music by doing some listening. Trusting that the Holy Spirit speaks through our deepest and holiest desires, both individually and as a body, I want to listen to what people are thinking and feeling about music at St. Ignatius. I began last weekend by having a wonderful conversation with the members of our various choirs. Choir members spoke about why they sing, what they see as the strengths of our music program and what they want to see preserved, where they believe our program can grow, and what are some needed changes. As I said, it was a fruitful conversation, and it gave some shape to my thinking about our next Director.

I also want to hear from you. The Holy Spirit also speaks through your deep and holy desires about our music program, and it is important for me to hear those, too. To that end, I hope you will participate in a survey we have developed, to share with me your thoughts on what you see as the strengths and areas for growth in our liturgical music program. Your input will also give shape to my thinking about the future of our music program. There are survey cards at the church welcome tables, by the side entrances, and in the parish office. There is also an online option available via our parish website and e-newsletters.

I thank you in advance for the time you will give to this important task. Music is an essential and critical part of our common worship. We have been blessed over the years, and I want to ensure that we continue to pray together as beautifully as we have these past years.

I commend this process to your prayers. And, as always,

## Interfaith Refugee Welcome Concert to Benefit Catholic Charities Center for Immigration Legal and Support Services




