
## First Reading

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting.



We believe that you are fully present in the bread that is blessed and broken and the wine that is blessed and poured out in the sacrament of the Eucharist.


Thank you for making us a part of you, the mystical Body of Christ, the Church.


Renew in us your sacrificial presence, and let us be united with you at this moment, so that, in all our thoughts, words and actions we may represent you, and love others as you love us.
