


As President of the Board of Directors, I am pleased to bring you this 2018-2019 Annual Report for the Catholic Foundation of Western North Dakota.

Because of your great faith and stewardship, the Foundation has seen yet another fruitful year. I invite you to spend some time with this report to witness the difference you are making, and as you do, please note some of the areas where the Foundation is looking to offer more support. In this year's report, we are highlighting the Bishop Zipfel Endowment Fund, Seminarian Scholarship Fund, and Individual Parish Endowment Funds.

Your Catholic Foundation has seen tremendous growth this year, which directly impacts the number of ministries supported and at what level. Net assets have increased by \$2,093,655 for total assets of \$32,907,523 (an increase of 8.3% over last year's report). As a result, I am proud to say that this year we have \$3,886,953 to distribute across diocesan ministries (an increase of 17.5% over last year's report).

In addition, the Foundation continues to grow and develop as an organization serving the people of western North Dakota with resources and opportunities for individuals and parishes to learn about, and participate in, our desire to "ensure the faith for generations to come". We have introduced our second annual Magi Appeal, an opportunity focused on supporting our local parishes and their missions in the community. Success of the Magi Appeal is a deep reflection of the generosity and faith of the Catholic people of western North Dakota.

The Foundation underwent a name change this last year, a name that will reflect its people-focused, diocesan-wide scope. These are exciting times for your Catholic Foundation!





Turning the ship around

Priestly vocations increased dramatically during Bishop Zipfel's time

When Bishop Zipfel was installed in the Bismarck Diocese, he quickly noticed that the average age of priests was high, not unlike many dioceses across the country.

"During Bishop Zipfel's time, we turned the ship around from dwindling numbers of priests to a strong number of priests and, even more importantly, the average age decreased dramatically," said Msgr. Tom Richter.

In the Bismarck Diocese, many of the priests were preparing to retire and the diocese needed priests to serve the people. In response, Bishop Zipfel invested resources to increase vocations.

One of those resources was to appoint a priest as full-time vocations director, a practice not widely adopted around the country. However, Bishop Zipfel found the man for the job in Msgr. Richter, ordained in 1996.

By 2002, he was the full-time vocations director for the diocese. When he began his assignment, Msgr. Richter said the number of men in formation for the priesthood for the diocese was below a dozen and the average age of active priests was quite high.

"It was of great concern for Bishop Zipfel that the diocese would have

a sufficient number of healthy, holy priests to serve the people of God," he said. "Vocations were a very high priority for him."

And, so was raising the standards for seminary formation and the admission process. According to Msgr. Richter, Bishop Zipfel instituted a much more rigorous battery of psychological testing and screening and in-depth background checks for seminarians. He also required the men considering the priesthood to spend a summer at the Institute of Priestly Formation so they could develop a strong spiritual life and a strong prayer life as a foundation for the man to become a "healthy, affectively mature man, rooted in friendship with Christ with a strong prayer life."

He sent Msgr. Richter to preach about vocations at all the parishes around the diocese and helped him to develop an annual vocation day for fifth graders that was held for a few years. Data was showing that youth about this age began to think about vocations to the priesthood and religious life. All the fifth graders from the diocesan Catholic schools gathered in Bismarck for workshops and learning sessions. Bishop Zipfel devoted several hours each year to speak to those in attendance about vocations.



Through the increase in prayer from lay faithful and an investment by Bishop Zipfel, the Bismarck Diocese became one of a handful of dioceses with an abundance of vocations. Monsignor Richter estimates that the number went from around 10 to as high as 23 under the direction and guidance of Bishop Zipfel.

The diocese continues to be blessed with a large number of vocations, thanks, in large part, to Bishop Zipfel's visionary approach that is continued by today's leadership.

Bishop Zipfel's legacy and passion for seminarians and priests lives on through the Bishop Zipfel Endowment Fund. The Bishop Zipfel Endowment Fund was established to honor our sixth Bishop of Bismarck. This endowment fund benefits seminarian education and the care of our priests.
