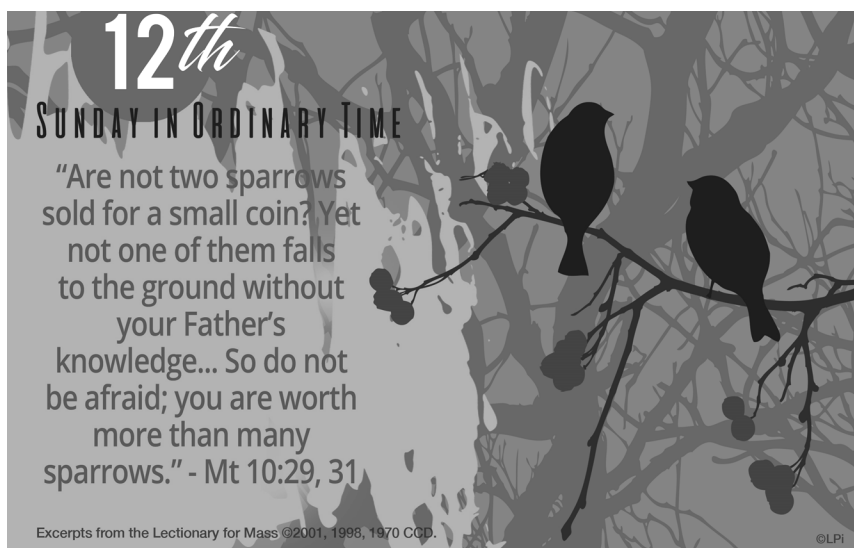

All volunteers and employees who work with minors at Immaculate Conception parish must be in full compliance with the Safe Environment Program. This includes:

1. Attend a **Protecting God's Children workshop** - register online at the Archdiocese website - www.archstl.org > Protecting God's Children
2. Sign the **Code of Ethical Conduct** - This can be completed on-line at the time of registration or booklets will be available the night of a class or in the Parish Office.
3. Undergo a **background check** updated in even-numbered years. Background checks are performed by the State of Missouri's Department of Health and Senior Services, Family Care Safety Registry. Forms will be handed out at the class or may be obtained at the Parish Office.

DEACON NEAL'S REFLECTION CORNER

Reading this Gospel, I'm a little confused. At the beginning, he told the apostles, "Fear no one". Then a little later he says, "...rather, be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna." Confused?

This is an example of why we have to be careful of interpreting scripture on our own. Jesus tells us often to not be afraid or fear not but with this "afraid", he's basically saying to avoid those kind of people that could hurt your soul. Our soul is more important than our bodily needs. How often do we say, "And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil" when we pray the Our Father.

As Jesus says in this Gospel today and in the words of the Our Father, "Don't put yourself into a situation that could lead to sin and hurt your soul."
