

Jeanie Riddle, 573-751-2757, ASAP to ask her support of HB1266, the Pain Capable Unborn Child Protection Act--a bill that would prevent abortion after a child is capable of feeling pain, about 20 weeks. Also, we need her support of HB 1383, which would require two notification for a minor to secure an abortion and HB 2589, which supports freedom of speech and would help prevent the establishment of buffer zones around Planned Parenthood clinics.


