Archdiocesan Lenten Regulations

Ash Wednesday (Wednesday, March 6) and **Good Friday** (Friday, April 19th) are days of **abstinence** for all Catholics **over the age of 14**. On these two days, fast, as well as **abstinence**, is also obligatory for those from the **ages of 18-59**. Abstinence means refraining from meat. Fast means on full meal a day, with two smaller meals and nothing between meals (liquids are permitted).

All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence from meat. Catholics will not hold themselves lightly excused, but if there is a serious health problem, this obligation would not apply.

We should strive to make all days of Lent a time of prayer and penance.




Fish Fry at OMKC Hall this Friday and every Friday during Lent except for Good Friday from 4:30-7:00pm. This
