# Today's Gospel Reflection

<u>First Reading</u>: Exodus 19:2-6a <u>Second Reading</u>: Romans 5:6-11 Gospel: Matthew 9:36-10:8

#### Discipleship

In the Gospel, Jesus is moved with deep compassion for those who suffer. He responds by sending out the twelve with a bold task: Cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, and cast out demons.

Being offered these readings alongside one challenges us to recognize that knowing we are beloved comes first—before any efforts of mission, ministry, or service. If we don't start with knowing our beloved-ness through and through, motivations get muddy. Rather than ministry being a freely given gift, our efforts can be driven by a need to prove our goodness and worthiness, to win praise and admiration. When we don't keep at our center the truth that we are God's precious possession, our attempts, to care can devolve into attempts to control. And this is a recipe for fatigue, resentment, and conflict.

Part of ongoing conversion as disciples of Jesus, sent out as laborers for the harvest, is growing in freedom.

Freedom to say "yes" to an invitation to service when we discern that we are called to share our gifts generously.

Freedom to say "no" to an invitation to service when it's not the right time or season for us to serve in that particular way.


Freedom to serve joyfully—whether those we serve respond with gratitude or indifference, appreciation, or annoyance.

Freedom to serve peacefully—whether others applaud us or ignore us. Freedom to know we are precious just as we are—that while we are called to do great things, our identity as God's beloved is never in question.

Freedom that comes from knowing we are beloved comes first, and all our actions overflow from that truth that can never, ever change.

Remember how much God loves you. Jesus still calls us to cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, and cast out demons. And we

begin to respond to that call by remembering when we have been borne up on eagle's wings, when we have God name us as beloved, precious, and chosen.





Exodus 19:2-6a / Romans 5:6-11 / Matthew 9:36-10:8

#### **BUCKET LIST QUESTIONS**

The Bucket List is a movie about two men, played by Jack Nicholson and Morgan Freeman, who find themselves sharing a hospital room, each diagnosed with terminal cancer. As they talk about the days that remain for each of them, they begin to



discuss what they would yet hope to experience before they die. Hence, the title of the film.

At one point amid their many escapades together, Freeman suggests that God is going to ask two questions when they stand before the pearly gates. Nicholson hears this and grows edgy, suspecting his eternal future may be at risk. Freeman then tells him that the first question will be, "Have you ever experienced joy in life?" At that, Nicholson beams with a silly grim that suggests he is thinking more of pleasure than he is of joy. Nonetheless, he decides his luck on eternal life has been more about himself than about others.

Religion is not just about "going to church" but also about "going from church into the world." That, in a sense, is what Jesus did when he named the twelve apostles and sent them out to heal, bring life, and overcome evil. It is also what we find ourselves sent to do amid the scattered events of every week-to bring - Fr. Joseph Juknialis joy into the lives of others.

Is there a right to health care? As a Catholic, what kind of obligation do I have to use my resources to help with the purchase of medicine for my brother?



His insurance won't cover the costs, and he's on a fixed income.

Saint John XXIII's 1963 encyclical Pacem in Terris (Peace on Earth) said people have a right to live and a right to the "means necessary for the proper development of life" (11). This text serves as a foundation for the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' speaking of a right to "basic" or "adequate health care" in their Ethical and Religious Directives for Catholics. What is not clear in Church teaching is who has the duty to ensure that right. In some cases, the state has taken this responsibility, but this need not be the case. The condition of millions of our brothers and sisters in Christ, however, urges us to action on their behalf.

Regarding the case of one's brother, the question is difficult because of the need for more information. What is the brother's prognosis? Is he taking care of himself responsibly? What do you feel capable of doing morally without placing yourselves and others in your care at risk?

Whatever one's responsibility to respond in this case, one's relationship with one's brother should be marked by compassion and a sincere desire and will to help in whatever way is morally reasonable.


