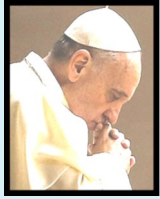
LET'S TAKE A MOMENT... By Tere Hunt

When someone close to you dies, the absence of that person leaves an aching in your heart, seemingly more painful especially since you have become attached and very familiar with the dearly beloved's presence. Accepting death is a difficult task but more than ever today, we are closer to accepting death. Deathbed visions and "crossing over to the other side" is no longer that of folklore but becoming widely accepted though cannot be explained easily. You hear of stories of the presence of the loved one who passed trying to get your attention, to let you know that they are okay. Or that you see the dearly departed vividly in your dreams, the smell of their perfume, or even profoundly feel their touch and distinguish their voice. In 2014, a similar encounter was experienced 2 days after my father was buried. Late in the evening, mom and I were in the midst of completing thank-you cards for those who attended the funeral service, when we were interrupted by the sound of a captivating yet fleeting melody that broke the tranquility of the night. So distinct was that brief interlude, I leaped from my chair and rushed towards the fading sound, crying out "Papa, is that you?" The angelic intermission left such a lasting impression that we could only determine my father was reassuring us he is in heaven, for how else could such a tune be uniquely delivered—by a harp? A phrase in the lyrics of the song states "where there is time, there is tomorrow." It speaks of a love that is eternal and forever, "of a love that is here, a love that is now to last for all time." Such a comforting and promising message especially for my mom, who continues her devotion, ever cherishing the fondest of memories they shared. Our minds cannot fully understand spiritual things. There are supernatural episodes we can never explain. We can only sense and understand there are such experiences that we just believe, we just do! In my heart, I picture my father playing that same refrain, grasping that same harp, anticipating our final reunion. Meanwhile, I shall endeavor to perfect that song on the piano!

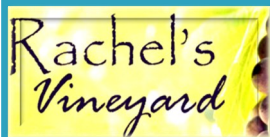

DIocese of Honolulu LENTEN REGULATIONS



FASTING

Catholics ages 18 through 59 are bound to fast on both Ash Wednesday (**March 5, 2025**), and Good Friday (**April 18, 2025**). To *fast* means to consume one full meal a day at most, although taking of other, smaller quantities of food at the other customary mealtimes is permitted. Food and drink between meals (except for water and medicine) is not permitted on days of fasting.

ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT

Catholics ages 14 and up are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday. To *abstain* means at least to refrain from eating beef, veal, pork, or poultry. Eggs and milk products are acceptable. The consumption of fish and shellfish is permitted, though the penitential character of the abstinence should be kept in mind.

EASTER DUTY

Fully initiated Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year. This precept is to be fulfilled during the Easter season, or for a just cause, at some other time during the year. This period is extended to include all the weeks of Lent and Easter up to Trinity Sunday (**June 15, 2025**).

LENTEN PRACTICES

The faithful are encouraged during Lent to attend daily Mass, receive Holy Communion, participate in penance services, and receive sacramental absolution; to take part in public and private exercises of piety, give generously to works of religion and charity, perform acts of kindness toward the sick, aged, and the poor; to practice voluntary self-denial, especially regarding food, drink, and worldly amusements; and to pray more fervently, particularly the intentions of the Holy Father.

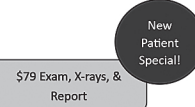
