





# Stewardship in Action

My name is **Ann Judilla** and I am the outgoing Pastoral Council Chair as of June 2025.

It has been a privilege for me to serve in this position for 2 terms. If you want a fulfilling volunteer work, I highly recommend being in the Pastoral Council either as a member or Pastoral Council chair as appointed by the Pastor.

The definition of Pastoral Council is a <u>consultative</u> body within the Catholic Church, at both the diocesan and <u>parish</u> levels, that advises the <u>Pastor</u> or <u>Bishop</u> on pastoral matters, helping to ensure the church's life and activities align with the Gospel.



### My History:

I came to Hawaii back in 1995 from Illinois where I grew up since I was 12 years old (1975) coming from Cebu, Philippines. My father was a Mechanical Engineer who applied to be an immigrant to the U.S. I grew up in the suburb of Chicago (in Gurnee and Waukegan, IL). I was baptized Catholic since birth and went to an all girl school ran by Franciscan missionaries of Mary in Cebu. When I came to the U.S., my dad wanted me to attend a Catholic high school, but I declined because I wanted to know about boys! I was never exposed to them in school. After attending a public high school, I attended a Jesuit Catholic University at Marquette University in Milwaukee, WI. I studied pre-medicine and went on to receive my Masters Degree in Public Administration and Management. I decided to go into research and worked in pharmaceutical companies notably, Abbott Labs, Merck and I retired at Novartis Pharmaceuticals. I worked in cardiovascular and oncology research. It was challenging but rewarding work especially when the drugs I worked on received approval from the FDA and were marketed for use by patients and hospitals. My life was hectic due to my job and I needed a voluntary work that could give me a life/work balance so I chose to participate in church volunteer work to give me that spiritual and human balance in my life.

I have been a member of the St. Jude Parish since my arrival from Illinois in April 1995. I first served as a Pastoral Council member back in 1997. I also served as a Religious Education teacher for 2nd graders from 1997 to 2003. I have been a lector since 1996. I coordinated fundraising activities for St. Jude such as bake sales and white elephant sales as part of fundraising efforts to build the current location of our St. Jude Church.

I have enjoyed being a part of this parish as a church member and being part of various committees. If I am needed I never say no to any request from our pastors past and present and I hope to continue working with Fr. Rheo in whatever role he needs me to volunteer.

I hope our church community will continue to help in stewardship and building our community. Our Pastor cannot stand alone. He needs help and cooperation from all of us in order to continue our programs and services so he can continue to provide also for our spiritual needs. I highly encourage everyone to volunteer through our various ministries.

If you need more information regarding the ministries here at St. Jude Church, there are pamphlets available providing background information in the back of the church. There is a lot of expectations to make St. Jude Church a mega-church for the Leeward side so my hope is for everyone to come together and volunteer and become good stewards! We want to build a legacy for our children and future members.

### **New Church Project, Schematic Design for Pricing at 100%:**
