LET'S TAKE A MOMENT... By Tere Hunt

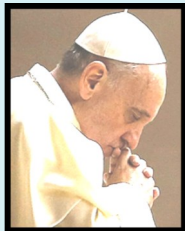

Who was responsible for crucifying Jesus? His execution was a conspiracy that involved King Herod, Rome's leaders, Jewish leaders, soldiers, various populace of Israel and the community at large then present who never formally operated together but mutually shared their attendance on that ill-fated day to fulfill the unimaginable. All who came to mock and jeer at Jesus, compelling Him to die on the cross are accountable. Jesus suffered severely, and throughout His trials, torture and crucifixion, His suffering was incredibly physical. Isaiah 52:14 tells us that Jesus' appearance was so disfigured beyond human likeness! Yet His anguish was as spiritual and emotional, He carried the weight of the entire world's sins, His brutal physical pain enhanced by paying for the guilt of our sins and died to pay that price. God allowed His only Son to be brutally slain, to be rejected and despised, a rite of passage whereby His punishment brought us peace, healing, and salvation. Jesus had to suffer because suffering is part of the sacrifice. His physical abuse was reparation for our sins. God must have such a distorted sense of anger to allow His only Son to be sacrificed to redeem humanity. Jesus committed everything that was tasked of Him, even when He begged "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from me... Yet not as I will, but as you will." Matthew 26:39. He drank the cup of suffering so we could be saved. In essence, we are all guilty of killing Jesus because it was our sins that put Him on the cross. God used the most evil of actions to bring about such a perfect plan to secure our redemption. Humankind considerably benefitted that by putting Jesus to death, we were saved! He surrendered His destruction for our redemption. What an outrageous plan to allow the mutilation of your only beloved Son to rescue those that had forsaken you! May you realize how blessed you are. May your hearts be inspired with His presence, and genuinely thank Him for the sacrifice He has bestowed us. Reflect that even with the chaos in your life, you can never match what He endured. **Happy Easter!**

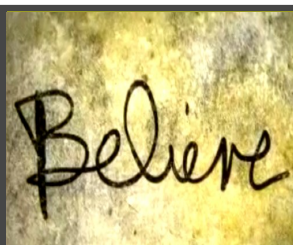

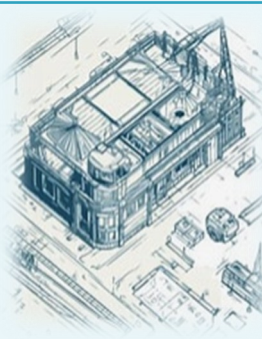
