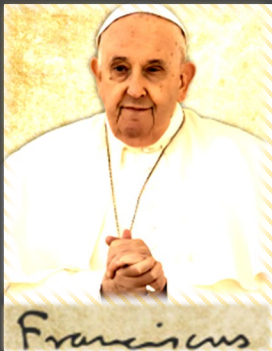

LET'S TAKE A MOMENT... By Tere Hunt

The head of the Roman Catholic Church and sovereign of Vatican City, Pope Francis, died on Easter Monday, April 21, 2025 at the age of 88. Argentinian-born Jorge Mario Bergoglio chose the name Francis from St. Francis of Assisi. Expiring a day after Easter, we venerate his last public appearance on Easter Sunday, demonstrating God's mercy in granting him ample spirited strength to deliver his final blessings to the multitude on such an auspicious day. He broke many papal traditions, wore simple vestments, even personally paid his own hotel bill after his election, preferring to reside at the Vatican's 2-room modest guesthouse. Swiftly immersing himself in the pulse of the times, he became known as the champion of the poor, reforming the Vatican's image of dictating policy into assisting bishops' function of evangelization and outreach. He pleaded mercy for the oppressed, firmly supporting refugees during humanitarian crises, comforting the sick, visiting prisoners, appealing for decriminalization of homosexuality. He exhibited delight in the presence of little children, “learning from them.” He advocated for the dignity of all people, vehemently opposing the death penalty. He dedicated his whole life to ending armed conflict, repeating appeals for the return of hostages, imploring for ceasefires, encouraging dialogue, expressing reconciliation among nations. His deep affection to the marginalized was constantly guided by his determination to reflect the compassion of Christ in his leadership. Remarkably, he promoted climate awareness and focused on global environmental issues. He had an immeasurable desire for everyone to recognize one another as brothers and sisters. Our beloved patriarch's departure marks a pivotal ending to his gift of humble service, defining grace amidst turbulent times, and an untiring dedication to the Gospel's mission of love and understanding for all. He has no doubt earned a place at Our Lord's kingdom. May he be a beacon of consummate inspiration to the ones who MUST continue his legacy. *Rest well in splendor, Santo Papa!*

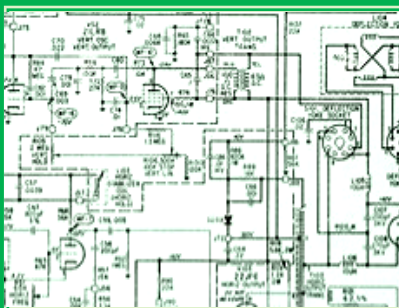

New Church Project, Schematic Design for Pricing at 100%:
