LET'S TAKE A MOMENT... By Tere Hunt

At a limited time only, specifically April 27—29th, theatres nationwide featured the full-length movie of *Carlo Acutis: Roadmap to Reality*. The 1.18 hr. documentary explored the legacy of this 15-year Italian who gained recognition for his devotion to the Holy Eucharist. This unassuming teenager became known as the Patron Saint of the Internet because of his use of communication techniques to transmit and interconnect the world about Christian values, emphasizing the relevance of faith in the digital age. At a young age, he expressed a special love for God, even dragging family members to Mass and confession. He became intrigued with the innumerable Eucharistic miracles around the world, dedicating his short life to cataloguing them on his website, which intuitively drew him closer to God. Thus became his virtuous journey to inspire countless souls to seek a deeper connection with the Almighty. He is remembered for his exceptional faith and ability to connect with the young people through his digital expertise. He had a passion for computers, film editing and layout of comics, volunteering these for the children and the elderly. Diagnosed with the most severe form of leukemia, his untimely death just a week within his diagnosis, Carlo offered his suffering for the pope and for the Church "so that he may not go to purgatory, but straight to heaven." His composure and devotion was an act of sacrifice, reflecting his deep faith and commitment to the Church. Two miracles attributing to his intercession, identified Carlo as the first millennial saint. But since Pope Francis' death, the canonization was postponed, a task that the new elected Pope must perform. Because of Carlo's love of travel and vast interest in the lives of saints, especially Assisi and St. Francis of Assisi, it is only fitting that his tomb be displayed at the Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi. Carlo's body was embalmed but venerated in a glass tomb where his body lies incorrupt, which in Catholicism, is most often seen as a sign that the individual is a saint. *Certo, San Carlo è en paradiso!*

Lazarus Anondee* (Secretary General & Assistant of the National Catholic Secretariat of Ghana); and *Fr. Gregorio Honorio, Jr.* (Vicar for Clergy whom they kept addressing as “their boss”). It was a memorable evening of extensive fellowship, camaraderie, music and most definitely, abundant food. The highlight of the evening, was the toasting and roasting of Fr. B, cheerfully riddling him with personal questions, to which he would simply grin and not offer anything revealing. Not to be disappointed, his fellow clergy delighted the attendees by delivering treasured jokes to everyone’s animated pleasure. When asked “*would he rather live in Hawaii in a one-room hut or in the middle of the Himalayas in a mansion,*” he seriously responded with a twinkle in his eye that he only wishes to stay “with his sheep!” which warmed everyone’s hearts because he meant St. Jude! We are saddened, but eagerly anticipate his return as soon as his visa gets issued by Immigration.

Easter Sunday Stewardship in Action

My name is **Lito Alvarez** and I was asked to share my story of how I devote my time, talent and treasure in our community.

I was born into the Catholic faith, baptized in San Diego, CA. My Godparents, Fred and Connie Cruz welcomed me at St. Jude more than 50 years after my Baptism. As the youngest male of my siblings, I was fairly easy going growing up. I married my high school sweetheart, Amy, after graduating high school and joined the Air Force. We have 4 adult children and 2 grandkids, and presently, happily empty nesters.

Amy and I moved to St Jude in January 2015. At that time, I sought out the Knights of Columbus council to see how I can integrate. Since my arrival, I volunteered in different positions and mentored my predecessor, Arman Rin as Grand Knight (Covid year 2020). When Arman left for Korea, I became Grand Knight for 3 years. As Arman and I were fairly new to the council, we wanted to maintain and respect the programs but also enhance them.

Tithing is defined as time, talent, and treasure – sharing the gifts from God we receive with others. Aside from our monetary contribution to St Jude and the community, let us not forget the time and talent part. This is where parish life really comes to life for me.

In my last parish, Amy and I taught 2nd year Confirmation CCD, RCIA and also volunteered at the parish as a lector and Extraordinary Eucharistic Ministers. The mission of the Knights of Columbus has been to take care of our families, help those less fortunate, pray for our community and do all of this with like-minded families. Our Knights programs have grown over the past 5 years with our ability to engage with the Mary Jane Home who helps women giving birth but are experiencing challenges. We volunteer with Sleep in Heavenly Peace to build beds for kids that were sleeping on the floor, became meal sponsors for Special Olympics, and facilitated families build their home through Habitat for Humanity. We started sponsoring seminarians to priesthood, offering prayers and monetary donations to assist them with their journey, helping provide funds to the St Jude Food Pantry that promote the distribution on Tuesdays and Thursdays, and just recently, started supporting the Rachel's Vineyard who provides post-abortive care.

It's through these programs that we can make our difference on this earth. Then standing at the pearly gates, we can honestly declare, *"We fed the hungry, clothed the naked, and consoled the bereaved."* Our vocation on earth is to lift each other to heaven—this is one of the first lessons I learned during the sacrament of marriage.

The Knights of Columbus, started by a Catholic priest, Fr Michael McGivney, is a collaboration between clergy and laity based on charity, unity, and fraternity. I cannot claim any of these successes without the support of the Knights and their families, along with our clergy here at St Jude, most especially Fr. Boniface.

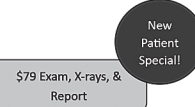
