#### LET’S TAKE A MOMENT... By Tere Hunt

How do you build strong relationships? When you make the effort to show your appreciation for the people who matter most to you—those who work for you—or those you do work for—it all goes both ways. By expressing they matter not just once, or twice, but constantly as you go through life! We often take for granted those who are closest to us. We assume we need not have to show appreciation for them because we deal with them daily, or they report to you in some function that helps make your job easier. Yet they are the same individuals, whether professional, personal, or familial that helps build the trust that you need to keep your position, that helps elevate your worth. Showing gratitude is simple, but it takes a conscious effort and practice to remind ourselves to show more gratitude to these people in our lives. Positive reinforcement is the easiest. Perhaps surprising them with an overwhelming act of appreciation, something you don’t do often: cleaning out their area, extra special treats which will overwhelmingly be appreciated too. But perhaps the more gracious way of showing appreciation is apologizing if you have been taking them for granted, because it is almost always worth it—an apology builds trust too. Be aware that there is the routine gratitude, a day-to-day expression much like when someone makes coffee. Exceptional gratitude is one that has gone an extra mile, doing more than the minimum. If you have the resources, share your wealth. If you have the time and ability to work with others, then get involved but find the balance to include your family. If you believe God has great plans for your future, then you should be expressing more joy in your daily tasks, sharing an appreciation towards others for the promise that is coming. How your inward sincere mind is manifested by your outward actions will matter the most.

Singing in church comes second nature to our choir member, **Eva Bartolome Ingasalo**. As young as 6-years old, she enjoyed singing, harmonizing with her siblings who would come together and do break-out routines during family gatherings.

During elementary school, she loved singing with the Catholic choir of nuns teaching religion at Columban College. She graduated from the same college with a degree in Accounting. Then after immigrating to the U.S. in 1993, she moved in with her parents residing in Waianae but was fortunate to work in town where she attended Mass at St. Therese Co-Cathedral, logically joining the choir in 2000.

She has a son, Espir Ingasalo III, whom she fondly called "EJ." As a working mother supporting her family, she went through several job positions, from working as an office assistant with the DOH in 1993, enrolling at the Hawaii Community College, taking Early Childhood Education, then as a Registrar at the Kalihi Waena Elementary School with the DOE in 2000.

In January 2017, Eva settled as a new homeowner in Makakilo but continued to attend church and choir practices at St. Therese Co-Cathedral. Because St. Therese Co-Cathedral is most often used for pontifical liturgies, its capacity can hold huge churchgoers as well as choir affiliates from other churches. She was exposed to meeting other diocesan choir associates who also utilized the church for their choir practices where she witnessed celebrations of several sacraments hosted by notable clergy, priest ordinations and episcopalian installations, the number of choir practices multiplying as such events came about. You can imagine her commute time too!

One significant circumstance truly touched her was when she was awarded the "Rose of the Month," for her exuberance and dedication to the choir. (Appropriately so being that St. Therese was known for her "shower of roses" to her devotees.) Eva would go the extra length to provide copies and assist in the various events held.

In 2023, she attended St. Jude and joined the choir and has actively been serving its various Mass schedules. She is also a member of the FCC and BCC.

Eva overcame numerous challenges in her private life, including raising EJ as a single parent for much of his life, with the support of her family and friends. EJ worked for NAVSFAC, the US Navy and US Marine Corp's engineering systems command as a civil engineer.

She is grateful foremost to her parents who paved her way to reaching the land of opportunity, and for the many wonderful people who gave her encouragement and support during the trying and struggling moments.

Her commitment to singing in the choir has been her joy and purpose. Through her singing, Eva gives glory to God, announcing His greatness and love to all.
