

# Stewardship in Action

## Written by Leah Pajimula (in the 3rd person!)

What does it mean to truly let God guide your life? For some, it's a quiet nudge to reach out to someone in need. For others, it's a dramatic shift—a leap of faith into the unknown. For **Leah Pajimula**, it's been both. Her life is a reflection of what happens when you listen for God's voice, trust in His timing, and walk boldly through the doors He opens.

Raised in a deeply faithful Catholic home in Hawai'i, Leah's love for God took root early. Her days often began at church, thanks to parents who not only brought her to Mass every Sunday but consistently reminded her of the importance of living with a spirit of gratitude. Their example helped Leah see faith not as a weekend obligation, but as a way of life. At **Our Lady of Good Counsel School**, her grandmother—who was also one of her teachers—nurtured both her mind and soul, teaching her how to pray and instilling in her the quiet strength that comes from trusting God completely.

With that foundation, Leah grew into a young woman of purpose. At just 16, she graduated from high school, and by 20, she had earned her degree in nursing at Hawai'i Pacific University. Driven by compassion and a desire to make a difference, she began her career as a Nurse Case Manager, helping injured workers navigate the often confusing and stressful road to recovery. She felt fulfilled, knowing her work was meaningful. But over time, she began to sense something more stirring in her heart—a pull toward deeper, more direct patient care.

That calling brought her into the intense and rewarding field of **Operating Room Nursing**. There, she could be in the heart of the action, standing beside patients at some of the most critical moments of their lives. Following that path led her far from home—to **Dartmouth Medical Center in New Hampshire**, an academic hospital affiliated with **Dartmouth College**, one of the prestigious **Ivy League** universities. It was a major life change, and making the decision to leave Hawai'i was not easy.


Leaving Hawai'i was not something Leah ever imagined doing. It took months of prayer, reflection, and countless conversations with God. She thought about it constantly. Could she really do this? Was this truly where God was leading her? The answer came not as a sudden lightning bolt, but as a quiet, steady reassurance: *With Me, you can do anything.* 

One of the most meaningful parts of her faith journey was her role as a **Lector at St. Jude Church**, where she served faithfully from 2021 until her move. Leah didn't take the responsibility lightly. She chose to become a lector because she wanted to be a vessel for God's Word—to proclaim it boldly and reverently, so that others

might hear not just her voice, but God's message of love and hope. Standing at the ambo, reading Scripture to her parish family, felt like both a calling and a privilege. It was her way of staying close to the Church, even during the busyness of her early nursing career.

Leah's life today looks very different from what she once imagined. But that's the beauty of letting God take the lead—He calls us to places we may never have chosen on our own, and in doing so, reveals the strength and purpose He placed within us all along. Whether she's in the Operating Room or in prayer, Leah continues to live her life as an act of **faithful stewardship**—offering her time, talents, and heart to God in everything she does.

And while the journey hasn't always been easy, one thing has remained certain: when you follow God with your whole heart, He'll never lead you astray.
