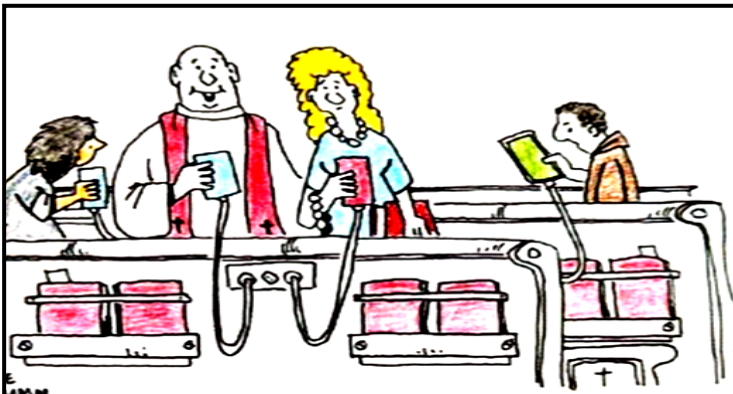
⁶ Shared for informational purposes only, updated annually, and subject to change; the \$27K is the monthly mortgage amount that St. Jude can currently afford based on present financial situation and mortgage assumptions; the \$64K is the goal amount required to afford a \$10M loan, which is a rough estimate of the loan amount necessary in order to complete building a new Church building/campus at the *Leihano* property; \$27K will be allocated each month into the Mortgage Capital Reserve for Fiscal Year beginning on July 1, 2025 and ending on June 30, 2026; this amount may increase or decrease in the next fiscal year.

While visiting my 94-year old mother at the final phase of our mainland trip, she meekly summoned me to bring pen and paper then sit awhile with her. She certainly sounded serious. *"What do you call it when you wish to say some words at a funeral service?"* she asked. To which I replied, *"A eulogy?"* She nodded quietly, then decreed, *"You will do mine...and these are what I wish shared..."* Gulping down my reaction, she methodically revealed stories of yesteryears, people's names, personalities, even those who passed, and anecdotes that impact her life. Her raspy voice echoed in my ears, my fingers trembling, racing to jot down words she uttered. Stealing a glance when I had a moment to inhale deeply, she was smiling, her expression distant and pensive, lost in her thoughts, and caught myself staring at my mother for the first time. *How long has she been contemplating on this eulogy? How long has she been preparing for this moment?* Deliberate in stating what she wants delivered, her voice would quicken when grasping for a proper description, then rattling off again; we burst into laughter when she described an amusing episode. I stumbled into the bedroom gripping the pieces of paper I wrote on like they were gold! Yet for the next two days, she would add to her list, each time I felt more comfortable yielding to her request. In jest, I teased her saying, *"If you keep adding to your list, I will have to ask the people to come back the next day for part 2!"* She liked that. And as I watch her amble across the kitchen, gingerly pick up an orange from the bucket of fruits harvested from her precious garden, tenderly slicing it, her frail hands clasping a piece into her upturned mouth, delighted at its sweetness. I followed her measured gait mesmerized at the grace and dignity she carries herself ever so gently. She hums a lot nowadays. I thank Him for keeping her wise through the eons I implored Him to keep her so!

THIS COULD BE YOU! By Kristin Fredette

Where are you from?

I was born and raised in Denver, Colorado. My twin sister (yes, I have a TWIN) and I were baptized when we were 3 months old! We didn't often attend church until I was around the age of 20 when I started thinking about God.

In the past, I have attended a few Baptist and Non-denominational churches but they really didn't peak my interest. In 2004 I met my husband, Steve, on a blind date of all things. He attended a catholic church and invited me to church one Sunday.

I had not had any sacraments at that time and I didn't know much about the catholic faith so he suggested that I look into RCIA. I completed RCIA in Colorado the same year! I think he knew before I did that we were going to get married one day, and we actually did a year later.

When did you move to Kapolei?

Steve, a firefighter, got stationed at Hickam Airforce Base in June of 2005 and moved to Hawaii first. At the time Steve lived here in Kapolei, his boss then was Dcn. John Coughlin who was already a resident of Kapolei. I moved to Kapolei in August 2005.

When did you decide to serve or volunteer your time to the church?

Because Dcn. John would talk about St. Jude in his conversations with my husband, we would attend the Masses at St. Jude. In 2008 I volunteered at St. Jude as a Eucharistic minister on a whim. Dcn. John's wife, Kathy, convinced me to "give it a try" and promised that it was really easy. I was thoroughly intimidated and super nervous, but she trusted her instincts and "trained" me. Looking back on that experience, I don't know why I was so nervous!

In 2012 one of the money counters pulled me aside and asked if I would join the money counting team. With horror in my eyes and body trembling I agreed to help and see what it was all about. When someone says a sentence with the word "money" in it, it is like you want to run the other way! I am one who hates math/accounting, but this ministry gives me a sense that I am using time and talent for St. Jude. It is actually very easy and shouldn't be looked at as being intimidating.

In 2024, Kathy again approached me and asked to help with the Environment or flower arrangements for the altar. Again with absolute HORROR, I agreed to help but with A LOT of reservations. I had no clue as to how to arrange flowers, especially for God and our church.

I also belong to the Rosary-Making Group that meets once a month. I wanted to learn how to make rosaries and because the same group crocheted leis of which I knew how to do, I thoroughly enjoyed doing both.

Most importantly, my husband had already joined the Knights of Columbus. The organization had a ladies auxiliary group in 2020

and I became part of the group. We did rosary-making and supported the many functions the Knights were involved in.

I also help the office staff at St. Jude. Weekends or weekdays, if I am needed, I am there.

Did you have previous interests that made you choose your volunteer work now?

I love to craft and create all kinds of greeting cards. I also scrapbook pictures from vacations and special occasions.

What would you tell others about volunteering their time for the church?

Being a volunteer at St. Jude has literally changed my life. I used to be so afraid of things and I was VERY VERY SHY. I also gained a second family by volunteering!

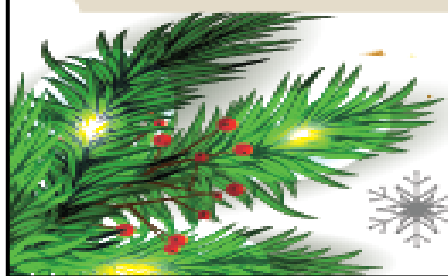

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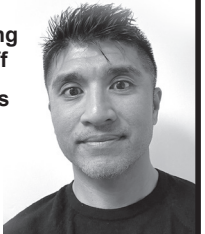
