³ Benchmarks include new categories of *Mortgage Capital Reserve* and *Moving Monthly Mortgage Allocation*; both goal amounts must be met in order for the design and construction of a new Church building and campus to be considered feasible at the future site of St. Jude Parish (at the *Leihano* property).

⁴ **Proposed Updated Budget divided by 52 weeks**; weekly collection amounts can vary according to season and celebration (e.g. Christmas collection, Easter Collection, etc.).

⁵ Capital funds reserved for design/construction of new Church building/campus; consider this akin to a mortgage deposit that is required in order to secure a loan for the remaining balance; these funds are not assessable (i.e. "taxable") by the Diocese of Honolulu; the goal amount is ½ the estimated construction amount, subject to change and based on latest estimates. **Adjusted for schematic design payment.**

⁶ Shared for informational purposes only, updated annually, and subject to change; the \$27K is the monthly mortgage amount that St. Jude can currently afford based on present financial situation and mortgage assumptions; the \$64K is the goal amount required to afford a \$10M loan, which is a rough estimate of the loan amount necessary in order to complete building a new Church building/campus at the *Leihano* property; \$27K will be allocated each month into the Mortgage Capital Reserve for Fiscal Year beginning on July 1, 2025 and ending on June 30, 2026; this amount may increase or decrease in the next fiscal year.

Fr. Clarence Zamora, our retired priest, shared insightful reflections which we can learn from and take up during our passage through Lent.

Lent begins Ash Wednesday. We will journey for 40 days towards Easter. But Lent is more than a journey of time, it should be a pilgrimage of re-discovery and discipline. It is time for self-denial.

Lent is not intended to be the latest installment of the South Beach Diet. It should be a time of feasting and fasting. I will share with you some selected thoughts inspired from a poem by William Arthur Ward, entitled *"Fasting and Feasting."*

"Fast from judging others; Feast on the Christ within them.
Fast from emphasizing differences; Feast on those things that unite us.
Fast from preoccupation with illness; Feast on the healing power of God.
Fast from words that pollute; Feast on words that sanctify.
Fast from discontent; Feast on gratitude.
Fast from anxiety; Feast on trust.
Fast from violence; Feast on peace.
Fast from bitterness; Feast on forgiveness.
Fast from fear; Feast on hope.
Fast from thoughts that weaken; Feast on promises that inspire."

Let us travel together, feasting, fasting, praying, sharing, blessing, and when we arrive at Jerusalem, we will be surprised to discover that Christ has been with us along our journey that started with us being marked with a cross made of ashes...that in reality, marked us as belonging to God.

We thank Fr. Clarence for these intuitive words. May we be inspired to make our season of Lent, renewed.

Diocese of Honolulu 2026 Lenten Regulations

FASTING

- * Catholics aged 18 through 59 are bound to fast on both Ash Wednesday (2/18/26) and Good Friday (April 3, 2026).
- * To fast means to consume one full meal a day at most, although taking of other, smaller quantities of food at the other customary mealtimes is permitted. Food and drink between meals (excepting water and medicine) is not permitted on fast days.

ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT

- * Catholics aged 14 and up are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday.
- * To abstain means refraining from eating the flesh, marrow and blood products of beef, veal, pork, or poultry at least, although eggs and milk products are acceptable. The consumption of fish and shellfish is permitted, though the penitential character of the abstinence should be kept in mind.

EASTER DUTY

- * All the faithful, after they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year. This precept is to be fulfilled during the Easter Season unless it is fulfilled, for a just cause, at some other time during the year. This precept is extended to include all the weeks of Lent and the Easter Season up to Trinity Sunday (May 31, 2026).

LENTEN PRACTICES

- * The faithful are encouraged during Lent to attend daily Mass, receive Holy Communion, participate in penance services, and receive sacramental absolution; to take part in public and private exercises of piety, give generously to works of religion and charity, perform acts of kindness toward the sick, aged, and the poor; to practice voluntary self-denial, especially regarding food, drink and worldly amusements; and to pray more fervently, particularly for the intentions of the Holy Father.



Please pray for the repose of the soul of Fr. Roland Emmanuel D. Pacudan, former pastor of St. Jude (1992-2001), who joined his Creator on February 17th at the age of 68 years old.

Born on Oct. 21, 1957 in Alicia, Bohol, Philippines, he was ordained as Deacon for the Diocese of Tagbilaran in 1982 then came to Hawaii, and was ordained priest. He served the Diocese of Honolulu for 26 years and worked as the Executive Director for the Galilee Center for Human & Economic Development (GCHED, Inc.) Many of our parishioners will fondly remember him officiating their sacraments. He wrote music and published 3 books, the most creative, *Secundum Ordinem Vitae*. 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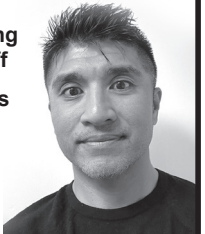
