³ Benchmarks include new categories of *Mortgage Capital Reserve* and *Moving Monthly Mortgage Allocation*; both goal amounts must be met in order for the design and construction of a new Church building and campus to be considered feasible at the future site of St. Jude Parish (at the *Leihano* property).

⁴ **Proposed Updated Budget divided by 52 weeks**; weekly collection amounts can vary according to season and celebration (e.g. Christmas collection, Easter Collection, etc.).

⁵ Capital funds reserved for design/construction of new Church building/campus; consider this akin to a mortgage deposit that is required in order to secure a loan for the remaining balance; these funds are not assessable (i.e. "taxable") by the Diocese of Honolulu; the goal amount is ½ the estimated construction amount, subject to change and based on latest estimates. **Adjusted for schematic design payment.**

⁶ Shared for informational purposes only, updated annually, and subject to change; the \$27K is the monthly mortgage amount that St. Jude can currently afford based on present financial situation and mortgage assumptions; the \$64K is the goal amount required to afford a \$10M loan, which is a rough estimate of the loan amount necessary in order to complete building a new Church building/campus at the *Leihano* property; \$27K will be allocated each month into the Mortgage Capital Reserve for Fiscal Year beginning on July 1, 2025 and ending on June 30, 2026; this amount may increase or decrease in the next fiscal year.

Those who used to attend church have found alternative methods to practice their faith, either through meditation or personal Bible study. They wonder what's the point of going to church if they insist on having a personal relationship with God. Not attending church will not send you to hell or make God love you less, but why do we go to church? Church is defined as an assembly or group of believers. Individual believers who are a living body, a universal group of people who trusted Christ through the ages. We are a family mutually dependent upon each other that worship collectively. If we do not attend church, then we deny what God intended for His people: *community*. God valued the church because that was what He did. Jesus went to the synagogues, calling His followers to do the same. By His example, we join a church because it is what Christ called us to do and who made us to be—members of His body. When we are in union with believers, we are in union with Christ. What an amazing place to experience spiritual growth! The church is a place where we can be inspired to model our lives after Jesus. We discover a sense of purpose—that we are here to serve, to help and to love. Yes, there are millions of reasons we could be doing on Sundays but those reasons outweigh receiving the Holy Eucharist, a sacred act of union with Christ! During Mass, we congregate and prayerfully prepare our heart and mind to receive Him, and when we do, we receive Him in reverence into our body—such an uplifting spiritual encounter shared in fellowship at church. When we come together not only to hear His Word, we also encourage each other in an intimate level. We witness the broken, the aged, the lost and confused, who still makes time to be in union with Him. So make a habit of meeting for worship, because IT IS a good habit. Make it a regular part of your practice. *"Some people have gotten out of the habit of meeting for worship. But we must not do that. We should keep on encouraging each other, especially since you know that the day of the Lord's coming is getting closer"* (Hebrews 10:25).
