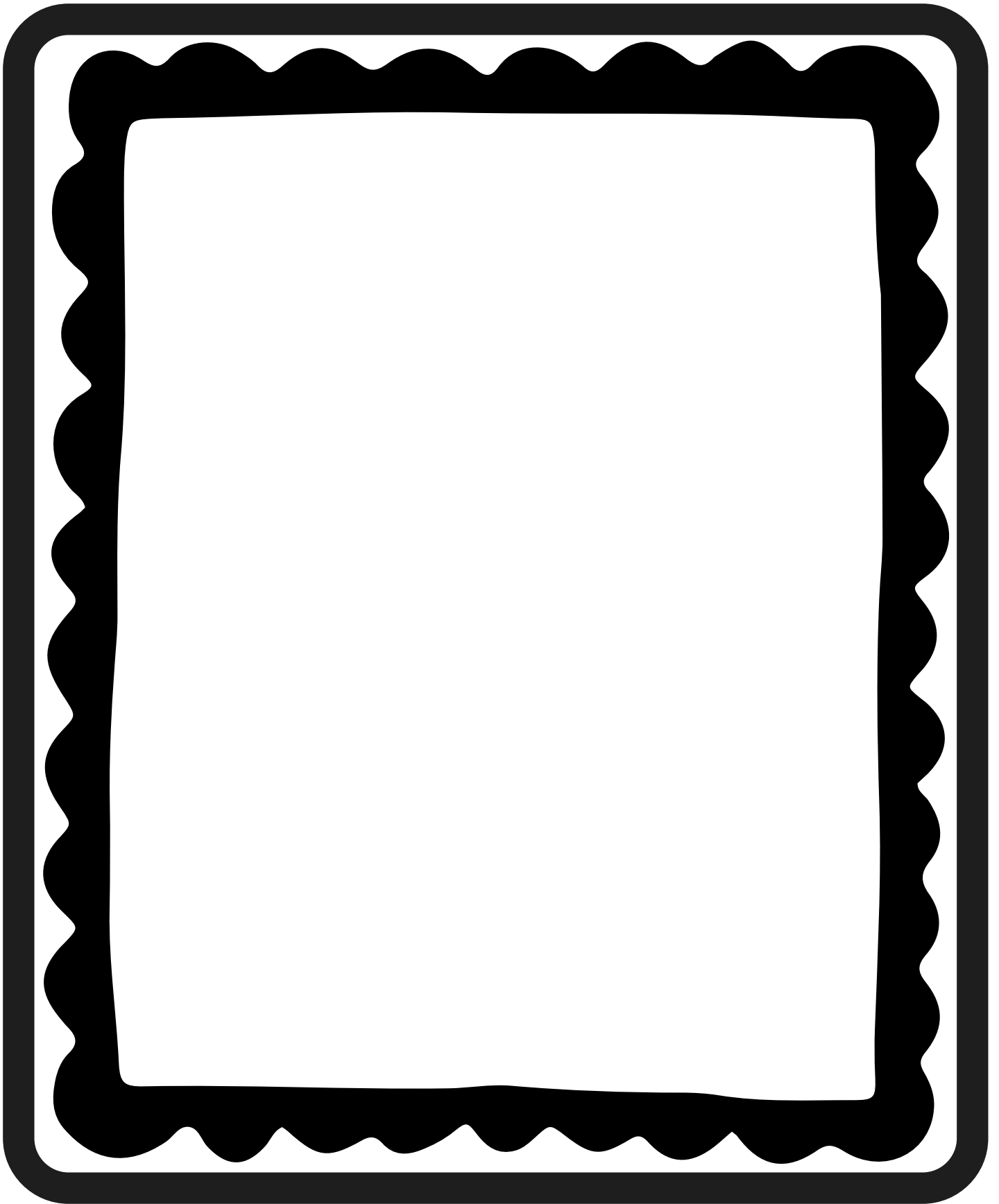
Here are the directions for the project.

1. You and your child will read The Night Before First Grade together.
2. Your child will draw a self-portrait in the attached frame. (The frame will need to be cut out. This is a great opportunity for your student to work on their cutting skills with safety scissors and adult supervision.)
3. Your child will fill-in the “Name” tag, the 3 “Likes” tags, and the 1 “Dislike” tag. (The tags will need to be cut out. This is a great opportunity for your student to work on their cutting skills with safety scissors and adult supervision.)
4. The self-portrait and tags will then be attached with yarn, string, or whatever other supplies you can find at home. (See attached picture.)
