Valley Christian School is excited to host the Trailways Conference Meet at Winagamie Golf Course. We look forward to welcoming you to the meet and we hope you enjoy the great course. We have 16 teams attending this meet and we greatly appreciate all your cooperation in helping us to host this awesome event!

Directions:

Address: 3501 Winnagamie Dr, Neenah, WI 54956.

Once you are on Winnagamie Dr approaching from the east or west you can head south into the golf course drive with your athlete buses or vans.

Please drop athletes off in the parking area and then park buses at the Twin Cities Rod & Gun Club (NW of Winagamie Golf Course on the north side of Winnegamie Drive). Spectator parking will be on Winnegamie Drive. Please only part vehicles on one side of the road as marked.

Tent City will be located along the east side of the entrance road and portable toilets will be available in the golf course parking lot. The entrance road to the clubhouse will remain open during the meet to golfers; please advise your runners to exercise caution when crossing the road due to golf course traffic.

Times:

2:30pm - Teams arrival and course opens for inspection

3:30pm - Coaches Meeting at finish line

4:00pm - Boys Varsity and JV 5k

4:40pm - Girls Varsity and JV 5k

5:20pm - Middle School Boys & Girls (~2500m)

~6:00pm - Awards will be presented as soon as possible after the conclusion of the MS race on the hill by the finish line.

Course Info:

The course will be lined and flagged. Spikes are permissible on the golf course. Some cart paths have been paved this summer, and athletes may have to cross or run along paved cart paths for short distances.

Runners are allowed to warm up on the two fairways east of tent city (holes 11 & 12) and on the 9 hole golf course used for the meet. There are 2 other courses to the south of the meet that are still open to public golfers. Please have your runners stay off those courses for their safety as they are being used by golfers. As is the case with all golf courses we use, please remind runners and spectators to stay off the tees and greens. Coaches: Please assist us in reminding your athletes to ONLY warm up and cool down on fairways of holes 11 & 12 which are the fairways closest to tent city.

Registration:

We will be using athletic.net for entries. The meet is on your athletic.net calendar waiting for you to do your registration. You may enter up to 7 varsity runners, and as many JV runners as you wish. Varsity and JV runners will compete in one race.

Entry Deadline is Tuesday, October 14th at 9am.


