RAIN DATE The rain date is the next day (May 17th). But we will make every effort to finish the meet on Friday night!

SPIKES We will allow ¼ inch spikes. Our shot and discus rings are concrete

BUS PARKING We do not want buses parking in the main parking lot. This is to keep as much of the lot clear for spectators as possible. Additionally, we would like buses to drop off on BRICTSON ST. (near the east end of our track). I have an attachment on this email as well. Once they have dropped athletes off, they are free to park on Brictson St or any of the surrounding side streets.

EVENT CHECK-IN: We will have a clerk of course on the EAST end of our track that will be giving as many instructions as possible. Before each heat, the athletes will then jog down the straightaway to the starting line. This is to keep the meet moving and prevent the officials from having to give too many instructions. Hip numbers will also be given out on the east end of the track. This is near the start for the 100 meter dash.

CONCESSIONS: We will have a concession stand open for the duration of the meet.
