Facilities: Eight lane 400-meter rubberized track and jumping surfaces.

Only 1/8 inch pyramid spikes allowed. We will check spikes in the bullpen.

Shot and Discus circles are both concrete.

Exchange Zones - Our track has the updated exchange zones, so you will only see 2 triangles per zone.

ONLY TAPE IS ALLOWED ON THE RUBBER SURFACES! NO CHALK OR TENNIS BALLS!

Thank you in advance for attending to this.

Restricted Areas: Only athletes in a current event are allowed on the infield. All coaches and spectators are **NOT** allowed in

this area. In addition, only those individuals with wristbands will be allowed inside the flagged areas at the

field events.

Hip Numbers: Hip numbers will be located in the bull-pen area at the north end of the track.

Locker Rooms: There will be no locker rooms available.

Team Camp Area: All team camps must be set up on the west side of the track outside of the fence.

Rest Rooms: Located at the entrance of the track.

Concessions: Located at the entrance to the track.

Buse Parking: Buses may drop-off athletes and coaches at the stadium in back of the school. Buses will then park in the

designated area on 11th street until the conclusion of the meet.

Admission: \$6.00 - 5 and under are free No passes allowed.

T-Shirts: Shirts will be available on a first come first serve basis for \$15.

Results: Posted on the fence on the south side of the bleachers and live on the link provided at a later date.

Meet Entries: The entry deadline is Friday, May 23rd @ 8:00 a.m.

All entries will be done online through Athletic.net. Detailed instructions for submitting entries are posted on the WIAA website (see link below). The entry deadline is Friday, May 23rd at 8:00 a.m. Coaches attempting to enter after the deadline will not be able to access the Athletic.net registration site. In the event that an athlete is inadvertently left out of the entries by the coach, refer the coach to the language in the Tournament Series Information (see link below) and have them contact the WIAA immediately.

2:00 pm Facility opens to all competing schools.

2:30 pm Weighing and checking of shots and discus at the white garage and inspection of vault poles at the pit area.

2:45 pm Coaches Meeting in north end zone – pick up packet of materials – **Please be prompt**

(We will run through the program for the event, answer necessary questions, and complete/hand-in all

necessary paperwork at this time.)

3:30 pm Boys pole vault to completion, 20 minutes for gender change and warm-ups

3:30 pm Girls high jump to completion, 20 minutes for gender change and warm-ups

3:30 pm Girls shot put, Boys discus to completion with 10 minutes between prelims and finals

3:30 pm Girls long jump, Boys triple jump, prelims until 4:30 pm, 4:45 pm finals until 5:15pm

Prelims will be open pit with 1 piggyback per athlete. Finals will be 1-1-1 in reverse order.

4:15 pm Girls 3,200 relay, followed by PA calls for the boys 3,200 relay, trials in the 100 dash and

100/110 hurdles (15-minute break before the running event finals).

Running event finals start with the 110/100 hurdles, all events called through the PA.

5:30 pm Girls triple jump, Boys long jump, prelims until 6:30 pm, 6:45 pm finals until 7:15 pm

*(If problems persist or opportunities exist we will modify the long and triple jump schedule; encourage

your jumpers to get their preliminary jumps in without haste.)
