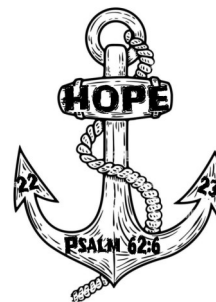

2. Select the Diocese of Kalamazoo as a location from the drop down menu.
3. Set up a username and password for an account.
4. Select the online training option and complete the training right away or choose a live training option.

Our Fast & Feast Lenten Program will kick off on Wednesday, February 22nd. More information will be coming soon.

During this special time—we invite students to wear a special theme shirt on certain days. These shirts may be ordered via the Google Order form that was emailed today. Orders are due **Today** January 25th. These shirts are optional. We do not require you to purchase one, however, on our special Fast & Feast color days, only these shirts can be worn.

The guidelines are:

- On Wednesdays during Lent, students can wear their Fast & Feast t-shirts. School uniform pants must be worn. Only solid, white, black or gray long sleeve shirts may be worn underneath. No donation to our Mission is needed.
- On Mondays during Lent, students can wear their Fast & Feast t-shirts for \$1. Non-uniform pants can also be worn on Mondays. Only solid, white, black or gray long sleeve shirts may be worn underneath.

This will show your support, as well as raise funds for the 7th & 8th graders you are sponsoring during their Lenten Journey.
