TRIP TIP: Reloadable gift cards are great to have in your physical wallet and can be added to your digital wallet in the app. Most gift cards will reload instantly, so you can add funds while you are in the store before you check out, like Target. A few stores take overnight to process adding funds, like Meijer. There are over 140 reloadable cards available. These are great for college students, as you can add funds to their card anytime.
