

Dear Parents,

On Tuesday, you should have received an email with instructions for re-enrolling for next year. Please take a moment to read through the instructions and re-enroll for the 23-24 school year. We believe we have worked out a few of the technical issues, but please let us know if you are having issues.

We firmly believe at St. Stanislaus School that each family that wants their child to receive a Catholic education should. We have been very blessed to again have an increase in our tuition assistance funds for the 23-24 year due to a donation to our trust fund from the Estate of Bishop Murray. Special arrangements beyond tuition assistance can be made by meeting with Mrs. Murphy and Father Derda. Tuition assistance applications are due by June 1st, 2023 and awarded before your first tuition payment is due. We have attached this form to this email. This form is also available on our website.

You can also decrease your tuition by using our TRIP, **TUITION REIMBURSEMENT INCENTIVE PROGRAM (T.R.I.P.)** The program works for you when you buy certificates from some of your favorite retailers and merchants. These retailers and merchants sell their certificates to Saint Stanislaus School at less than their face value. The discount savings will then be applied directly to your tuition account.

We will again be offering the opportunity for you to volunteer your time and receive \$300 in tuition credit by working either at the Polish Festival in August or the sub sale in January/February.

TRIP TIP: Eating out is more expensive these days, even fast food. Be sure to take advantage of using gift cards to pay for those meals. Rebates start at 2% for McDonalds and go up to 13% for many chains - more if there is a bonus. Many are in the 8-12% range. So, if you plan on splurging for dinner out for Valentine's Day, order some gift cards. If you are not sure where to go yet, you may be able to get an e-card just before you head out. There are many chain restaurants that offer e-cards.
