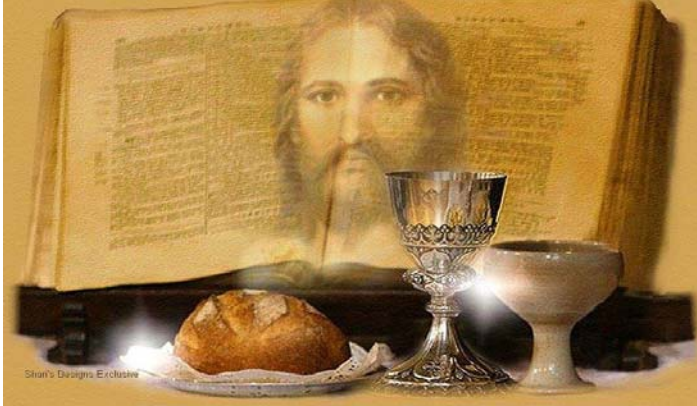

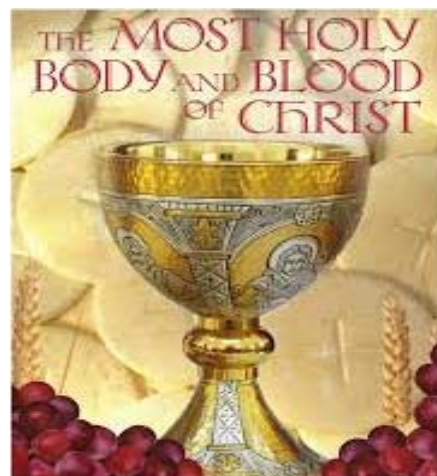
KEEPING IN TOUCH

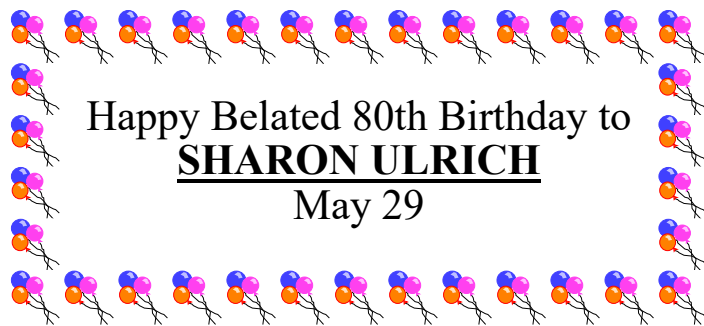

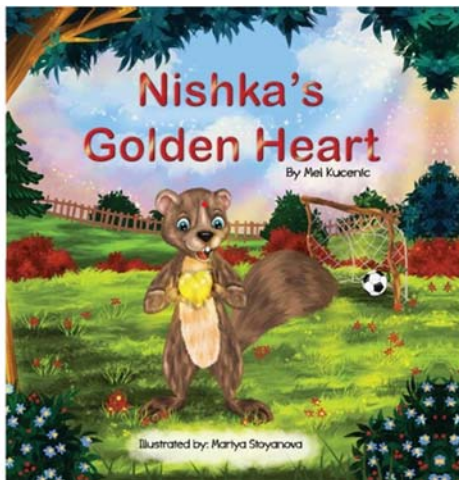
