I know that you will all be surprised to learn that this past week was yet another very busy week for me. Lots of meetings, lots of paperwork, masses, and hospital visits. While this was a busy week, I want to acknowledge the fact that we are in the midst of the week of Prayer of Christian Unity. As you may recall, one of the hats that I wear for the Archdiocese is that I am the Ecumenical Interreligious Officer. This week of prayer was begun in 1908 by Fr. Paul Wattson. In 1916 it was extended to the whole church to observe. Fr. Wattson had been an Anglican priest and Superior of an Anglican community of religious men. He and his community converted to Roman Catholicism and today are known as the Franciscan Friars of the Atonement. Over the years his community has done great work in the Ecumenical movement. In spite of all the good work and all the prayers, we still find ourselves lacking the oneness that Jesus calls us to. It is the desire of the Lord that we all be one and of that oneness be real. As we come to the end of the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, I invite you to join me in praying that the prayer of Jesus, that we all be one, may one day become a reality.



God of light, you have called us out of darkness into your light. May our response to your call lead us to actively seek reconciliation and share your light in the world. Amen.






