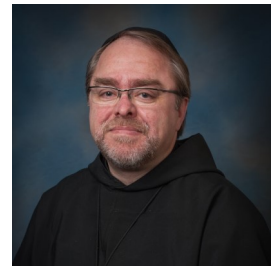
KEEPING IN TOUCH

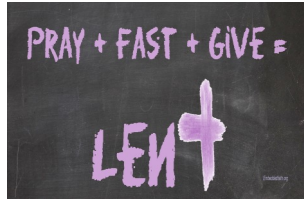
