Presentation on Cleaning Gravestones and Locating Unmarked Graves



Join us for an informative session followed by a visit to three local cemeteries on July 28th at 3:00 pm at the Croghan Town Offices, 9882 State Route 126, Castorland, NY 13620.

The presentation will begin with a talk by Laurie Rush from Fort Drum. She will expertly cover the proper techniques for cleaning headstones and share valuable methods for locating unmarked grave sites.

After the talk, the presentation will continue at the Village of Croghan's Basselin Cemetery for a hands-on demonstration on how to locate unmarked graves. St. Stephen's Cemetery will be the next stop where the presentation will be on best practices for cleaning headstones. The day concludes with stop at the Jerden Falls Cemetery for another demonstration on locating unmarked graves.
