PASTOR'S NOTES

A D-I-Y Study on this Sunday's Readings

Our Sunday gospels have been giving us strong and personal challenges lately, while this week Christ's words are more encouraging. The apostles express the weakness of their faith, and rather than just trying harder they do what we all must do: turn to Jesus to fill in where we are deficient. How is your faith or another aspect of your life weak? How can you pray for help?

"The apostles said to the Lord, 'Increase our faith."" This request from the apostles comes immediately after Christ spoke to them about forgiveness. "Even if [your brother or sister] sin against you seven times in a day and seven times come back to you saying, 'I repent,' you must forgive them." Those are challenging words that could make us feel indignant and stubborn or remind us that we need God's help. Gladly, the apostles responded with the latter. Faith is a gift from God. We turn to God for help because he helps us turn to him! Where have you come up against some of your inadequacies? How can you turn that frustrating experience into prayer?

"If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to (this) mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you." The image on the front of this bulletin is a mulberry tree. It is a large tree with an extensive root system. It would be difficult to uproot this tree, and basically impossible to grow it in seawater. Jesus uses a bit of a ridiculous example to tell his apostles that genuine faith, that is, surrender, can bring about quite unexpected results. Surrender is at the root of the 12 Step programs that have helped many achieve sobriety in their lives. Surrender can free us from the many anxieties we carry too often. What are you trying to keep control of in your life, even though it is clearly not working? Speak to God about that now.

"We are unprofitable servants. We have done what we were obliged to do." It seems strange that Jesus makes this point about working hard right after telling his apostles about the necessity of faith. There are two sides to being a disciple: with faith we can do anything, but we must continue to labor until the end. The labor flows out of our faith that God will work out his perfect plan. Laziness that masks itself as faith is rooted in no trust at all. How can you approach your work with greater trust?
