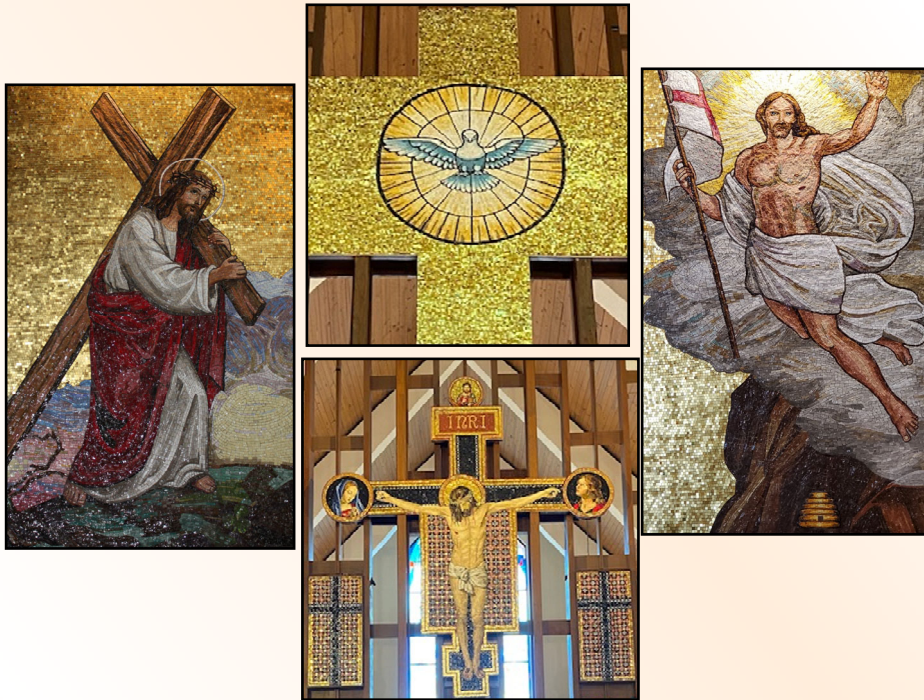

Message from the Pastor

What are you thankful for? It's a simple question to ask. The words roll off the tongue like a worn-out cliché. People may ask in regular conversation. Countless social media posts with this question will weave in and out of timelines and feeds.

There will be many different answers to this question. Some will give deep philosophical or theological answers about life and God. Others will give seemingly more simple answers like family and friends. There will also be those who won't be able to give any answer.

For many, giving thanks doesn't come naturally. In fact, it can be a very difficult task. This doesn't mean life is bad. Some simply find it hard to think of good things.

When a challenge or a problem comes up in our lives, we focus most of our attention and energy on it. That's not necessarily a bad thing. This can help us overcome difficulties better and quicker. How do you think it would make someone else feel to receive a letter like that?

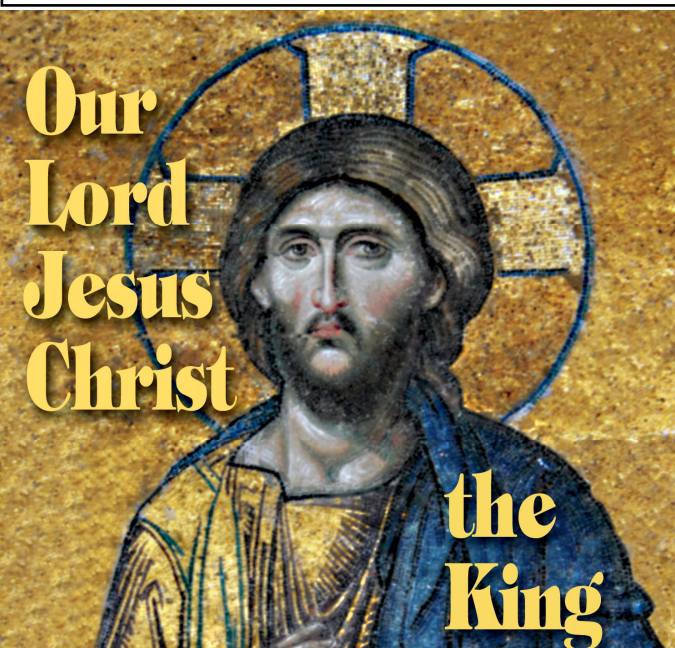

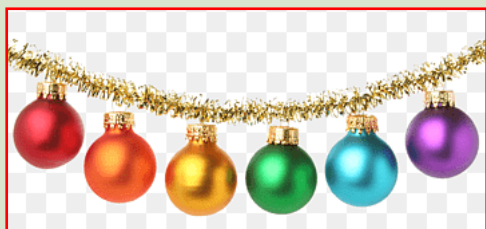

For more than 50 years, the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD) has supported organizations that combat poverty and improve the lives of people in communities across the United States. From empowering immigrants in towns along the southern border to advocating for improved housing and educational opportunities in northern and midwestern cities, CCHD-funded groups tackle a wide range of economic and social justice challenges that affect local communities in rural and urban areas.

In areas of Tennessee where coal-mining operations and landfills have caused water pollution and other environmental damage, Statewide Organizing for Community eMpowerment (SOCM) works with governments and regulatory agencies to limit hazardous waste disposal in landfills and to require environmental cleanup as part of the permitting process for new business operations.

Environmental damage affects all of us, most especially low-income people who are affected by water pollution resulting from mineral extraction, lack of access to healthy foods in urban “food deserts,” and natural disasters caused by climate change. The Church teaches that “the natural environment is

a collective good, the patrimony of all humanity and the responsibility of everyone” (Pope Francis, *Laudato Si'*, no. 95). Since the release of *Laudato Si'* in 2015, CCHD has invested more than \$4.3 million in organizations that work to protect the environment and combat pollution. When you support CCHD, you support organizations that work to protect the air, soil, and water for all the members of their communities.

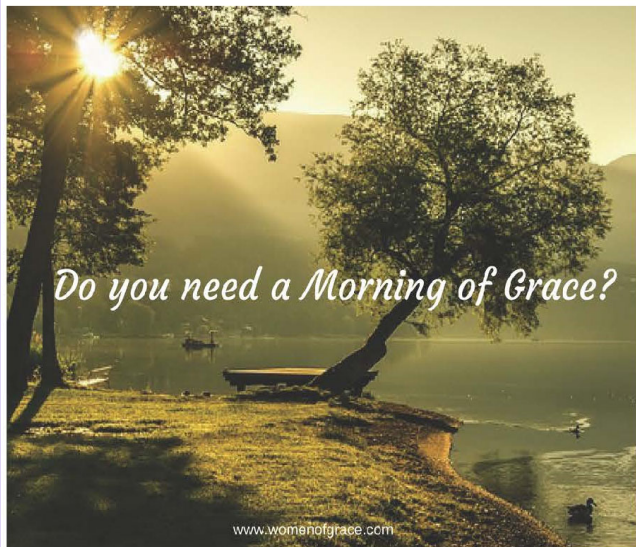
