The neighbor in today's Gospel, the good Samaritan, is not. Samaritans were seen as outcasts by the Jewish people who frequented the road from Jerusalem to Jericho. Yet it was this foreigner, this outsider, this stranger, who is the true neighbor to the Jewish victim. Dressing Appropriately for Mass

Now that Summer is here, please remember modesty before God and neighbor. Make sure your attire is appropriate to worshiping God and would not lead another to sin.

From the desk of Fr. Rojas...

In our American culture, the season of summer is a time dedicated by many families and persons to taking **time off**, to go on **trips and vacations**, and to seek **regeneration** from the hustle and bustle of the school year as well as so many activities and occupations that seem to pick up the pace in autumn. Thus, the questions are **not** whether to rest **but** how and with whom to rest in this life **and** what we communicate to God and to the people around us, *especially our children*, *godchildren*, *and grandchildren*, as to whether we wish to rest **in** Him and **with** Him in the hereafter.

The love and the lordship of God for us extends into the realm of rest and leisure. How do we respond to God's love in the realm of rest and leisure? How do we teach our children, godchildren, and grandchildren to reciprocate God's love in this realm? Among the "commandments and statutes" in Dt 30:10-14, our first reading for Mass in the Ordinary Form today, is the Third Commandment: "Remember to keep the Sabbath day holy." Exodus 20:8-11. As part of the new Israel, the Church, we Catholics understand that Sunday is the Lord's Day thanks to the Resurrection of Christ. Thus, Sunday is sacred, that is, set apart to rest in God and then with family and friends in wholesome rest and leisure. God did not merely set aside a day of rest – starting in and with Him at divine worship – in the Old Testament and then in the practice and prayer of Christians since the very beginnings of the New Testament era, also known as part of the Apostolic Tradition. Through the Church founded by Our Lord, God has taught us how to keep that day of rest, namely by orienting Sunday towards the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass for us and our families and then towards wholesome rest and leisure with family and friends.

As we make travel plans this summer, especially over the weekend, let us go on vacation with God in our plans and not away from Him. As we compare airfares, hotel rates, restaurants, etc., let's keep our life-giving connection to God strong (we Catholics call this "living in a state of grace") also by researching where there is Holy Mass available for us on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation (please dress appropriately for Mass and not merely for the beach) as well as confessions. We do well as Catholics both for ourselves and to give good examples to future generations to take time for private and family prayer too. Last I looked, there is no "vacation" exception to our need and our duty to reciprocate God's love for us in the realm of rest and leisure. In the Gospel of today in the Ordinary Form (Lk 10:25-37), Our Lord called correct the scholar's answer to "...love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your being, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself." That answer also includes our rest and leisure, whether we are away on vacation or a day trip, or whether Religious Education classes are in session or not.




