



## **Foundation Contributions**







## What is TuitionCare?

- ➤ Would you rather direct your taxes to Harrisburg or St. Thomas?
- TuitionCare is a unique program established by the Foundation for Catholic Education that takes advantage of the EITC Program offered by the State of PA to benefit St. Thomas families in grades K-8.
- This program allows you to control and direct where your PA state tax dollars go, receive a 90% Tax Credit AND reduce your Tuition!
- ➤ All St. Thomas school families from grades K-8 benefit from TuitionCare regardless of their participation or contribution amount. However, the more participants, the lower tuition is for K-8 families!



## How does it work?

- **Participants (School Families and St. Thomas Parishioners)** contribute funds to the Foundation's Special Purpose Entity (SPE), a legal entity created with a predefined purpose (supporting Catholic Education).
- > The Foundation will then issue \$1,000 to St. Thomas for every participant.
- > St. Thomas will distribute the total Tuition Reduction Grant (TRG) evenly among all K-8 school families.
- ➤ In parallel, **participants** will receive a 90% tax credit from the State.
- The commitment to TuitionCare is for two years, after the 2 years the Foundation will automatically re-enroll you unless you choose to opt out of the program.

## **TuitionCare: Benefits to the School Families**

- > YOU GET TO CONTROL WHERE YOUR PA TAX DOLLARS GO!
- With **TuitionCare** the Foundation will issue a Tuition Reduction Grant to the School.
  - $\circ$  **Tuition Reduction Grant = \$1,000** X the number of St. Thomas participants.
- ➤ The School will apply the Tuition Reduction Grant as follows to effectively reduce tuition for all School Families grades K-8.
  - Tuition Reduction per family = Total Tuition Reduction Grant # of Current K-8 School Families

**Note:** Tuition Reduction is capped at \$1,000 per School Family

## **TuitionCare Participation Goals**

### 100% Participation, 214 K-8 Families

- ➤ K-8 Families Enrolled in the School: 214
- School Families & Parishioners who join: 214
  - Tuition Reduction Grant = \$214,000 (214
     x \$1,000)
- Reduction in Tuition = \$\frac{\$214,000}{214 \text{ K-8 School Families}}\$

Tuition Reduction Grant per Family: \$1,000

#### 50% Participation, 107 K-8 Families


- ➤ K-8 Families Enrolled in the School: 214
- > School Families & Parishioners who join: 107
  - Tuition Reduction Grant = \$107,000 (107 x \$1,000)
- Reduction in Tuition = \$\frac{\$107,000}{214 \text{ K-8 School Families}}\$

Tuition Reduction Grant per Family: \$500

## **5 Simple Steps**

- 1. Review line 12 on PA-40 Tax Form to understand your current tax liability.
- 2. Fill out Commitment Form with the amount you are contributing to St. Thomas the Apostle TuitionCare.
- 3. Foundation will notify you when it is time to write your check.
- 4. Receive your K-1 from the Foundation in February/March.
- 5. File taxes, complete your PA-40 tax form and enter your 90% Tax Credit.


## What is a Special Purpose Entity?

- A Special Purpose Entity is an LLC that the Foundation has created to allow individuals who want to support Catholic education to participate in the EITC/OSTC programs.
- The sole purpose of the SPE is to direct EITC/OSTC funds to families sending their children to our Catholic schools.
- The Foundation for Catholic Education will handle any communication with the State.
- > **SPE Members** receive a 90% PA Tax Credit for a Two Year Commitment.



## **SPE Particulars**

- Refund Timing
- Cash Flow/Time Frame
- Non-Profit Employees
  - Exceptions include stock owners or joint filers with forprofit employee



## **Five Simple Steps!**

- > Fill out commitment form & confirm your commitment with the Foundation
- ➤ Mail your check in the Fall
- > Receive your K-1 in February of 2022
- > Complete your taxes and use your credit
- > Repeat for a second year

### **TuitionCare Timeline**

### March-September

#### Sign-Up

New Members have the ability to sign up on a rolling basis throughout the year. The final push will be made in these months.

#### **August 15**

#### **Touch Base**

> An e-mail will be sent to the current/new members of TuitionCare reminding them that the Foundation will be reaching out soon about their contribution.

### **September 30**

#### **Check Notification**

An e-mail will be sent to members letting them know WHO to write the check to and WHEN it is due.

#### **November 30**

#### **Check Due**

- Checks will be due to the Foundation.All necessary
- All necessary information will need to be collected by this point as well, including SSN.

#### **January 15**

#### TRG

- ➤ Tuition Reduction Grants will be distributed to schools.
- > Schools will reflect the TRG on families tuition statements.

#### **February 28**

#### K-1

- The Foundation
  Accounting Team
  will mail out paper
  copies of members
  K-1s.
- If any information needs to be changed, members must notify the Foundation immediately.
