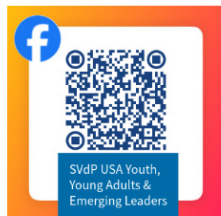

St. Pier Giorgio Frassati was a young Italian Catholic known for his deep faith, love for the poor, and joyful service to others. As a member of the Society of SVdP, he regularly visited and assisted those in need, seeing Christ in the poor and vulnerable. His example continues to inspire Vincentians to live out charity with compassion, humility, and friendship.
