

Dear St. John Vianney parishioners,

January 22, 2023 was the 50th anniversary of Roe v. Wade, the Supreme Court case which made abortion legal in the United States in virtually all circumstances. On Friday, June 24, 2022, in Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization, the United States Supreme Court overturned Roe v. Wade which, up to that point, had guaranteed a constitutional right to abortion in all 50 states. In effect, the Supreme Court decided that individual states can decide for themselves what to do regarding abortion. Some states have restricted abortion greatly, such as Idaho, South Dakota, Texas, Oklahoma, Missouri, Arkansas, Alabama, Georgia, West Virginia, Kentucky, Mississippi, Tennessee, and Louisiana. In other states such as Arizona, Montana, Utah, Wyoming, North Dakota, Iowa, Indiana, and Ohio, the restrictions on abortion are being blocked as courts decide what happens next. Some states, such as Washington, Oregon, California, Alaska, Hawaii, New Mexico, Minnesota, Illinois, Michigan, New York, Maine, Massachusetts, New Jersey, and Maryland, have no ban on abortions. Lastly, some states, such as Nevada, Colorado, Nebraska, Kansas, Pennsylvania, New Hampshire, Virginia, and South Carolina, limit what is considered legal regarding abortion. As you can see, while Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization ended Roe v. Wade, but it did not end abortion in this country.

In response to the ending of Roe v. Wade and this new era in the Pro-Life movement, the Diocese of Phoenix began a diocesan-wide ministry called "Walking with Moms in Need." This ministry is not only being implemented throughout our Diocese; it is being implemented in all Dioceses in the United States. Today's 2nd collection will go toward supporting this and other Pro-Life ministries in the Diocese of Phoenix, and a 1/3 of the collection will go toward supporting Pro-Life efforts at our Parish.

As I've shared before, I was born in 1977, and my parents were not married when I was conceived. My mother was 19 years, and my dad was 20. It would have been easy and legal for my parents to have aborted me at that time. Later in my life, when I was 17, I would go to the Pro-Life March in Washington, D.C., and it was at the Pro-Life Vigil Mass the night before the March that I first heard God calling me to the priesthood. I am thankful that my parents got married and that I was born. I also believe that it was not a coincidence that God called me to be a priest at the Pro-Life March. I have been praying my whole life for an end to abortion.

We have entered a new time in our country regarding abortion. There are states where abortion at any time during pregnancy is legal, and there are states where there are many restrictions on abortion exist. Our job as Catholics is to continue standing for life, praying for an end to abortion in all 50 states, and offering support for mothers and fathers who are in need as well as healing after abortion through retreats such as Project Rachel Retreats.

If you or someone you know has had an abortion, I would be happy to talk with you about how to go through a healing process. To be clear, I'm not here to judge or condemn you. Instead, I want to help you receive God's mercy, forgiveness, and healing love. Please don't hesitate to contact me. Likewise, if you or someone you know needs help and support with their pregnancy, we here at St. John Vianney Parish are happy to help in any way possible.

21-22 de Enero – 3er Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Estimados feligreses de St. John Vianney,

El 22 de Enero de 2023 fue el 50 aniversario de Roe v. Wade, el caso de la Corte Suprema que legalizó el aborto en los Estados Unidos en prácticamente todas las circunstancias. El viernes 24 de junio de 2022, en Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization, la Corte Suprema de los Estados Unidos anuló Roe v. Wade que, hasta ese momento, había garantizado el derecho constitucional al aborto en los 50 estados. En efecto, la Corte Suprema decidió que los estados individuales pueden decidir por sí mismos qué hacer con respecto al aborto. Algunos estados han restringido en gran medida el aborto, como Idaho, Dakota del Sur, Texas, Oklahoma, Missouri, Arkansas, Alabama, Georgia, West Virginia, Kentucky, Mississippi, Tennessee y Louisiana. En otros estados como Arizona, Montana, Utah, Wyoming, Dakota del Norte, Iowa, Indiana y Ohio, las restricciones al aborto se están bloqueando mientras los tribunales deciden qué sucederá a continuación. Algunos estados, como Washington, Oregón, California, Alaska, Hawái, Nuevo México, Minnesota, Illinois, Michigan, Nueva York, Maine, Massachusetts, Nueva Jersey y Maryland, no prohíben el aborto. Por último, algunos estados, como Nevada, Colorado, Nebraska, Kansas, Pensilvania, New Hampshire, Virginia y Carolina del Sur, limitan lo que se considera legal con respecto al aborto. Como puede ver, aunque Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization terminó con Roe v. Wade, pero no terminó con el aborto en este país.

En respuesta al final de Roe v. Wade y esta nueva era en el movimiento Pro-Vida, la Diócesis de Phoenix inició un ministerio diocesano llamado "Caminando con las mamás necesitadas". Este ministerio no solo se está implementando en toda nuestra Diócesis; se está implementando en todas las diócesis de los Estados Unidos. La segunda colecta de hoy se destinará a apoyar este y otros ministerios Pro-Vida en la Diócesis de Phoenix, y 1/3 de la colecta se destinará a apoyar los esfuerzos Pro-Vida en nuestra Parroquia.

Como he compartido antes, nací en 1977 y mis padres no estaban casados cuando me concibieron. Mi madre tenía 19 años y mi padre 20. Hubiera sido fácil y legal para mis padres abortarme en ese momento. Más tarde en mi vida, cuando tenía 17 años, iría a la Marcha Pro-Vida en Washington, D.C., y fue en la Misa de la Vigilia Pro-Vida la noche antes de la Marcha que escuché por primera vez a Dios llamándome al sacerdocio. Estoy agradecido de que mis padres se casaron y de que yo nací. También creo que no fue casualidad que Dios me llamara a ser sacerdote en la Marcha Pro-Vida. He estado orando toda mi vida por el fin del aborto.

Hemos entrado en un nuevo tiempo en nuestro país respecto al aborto. Hay estados donde el aborto en cualquier momento durante el embarazo es legal, y hay estados donde existen muchas restricciones sobre el aborto. Nuestro trabajo como católicos es continuar defendiendo la vida, orando por el fin del aborto en los 50 estados y ofreciendo apoyo a las madres y padres que lo necesitan, así como sanación después del aborto a través de retiros como Project Rachel Retreats.

Si usted o alguien que conoce ha tenido un aborto, me complacería hablar con usted sobre cómo pasar por un proceso de curación. Para ser claro, no estoy aquí para juzgarte o condenarte. En cambio, quiero ayudarte a recibir la misericordia, el perdón y el amor sanador de Dios. Por favor, no dudes en contactarme. Del mismo modo, si usted o alguien que conoce necesita ayuda y apoyo con su embarazo, aquí en la parroquia de St. John Vianney estamos felices de ayudar de cualquier manera posible.
