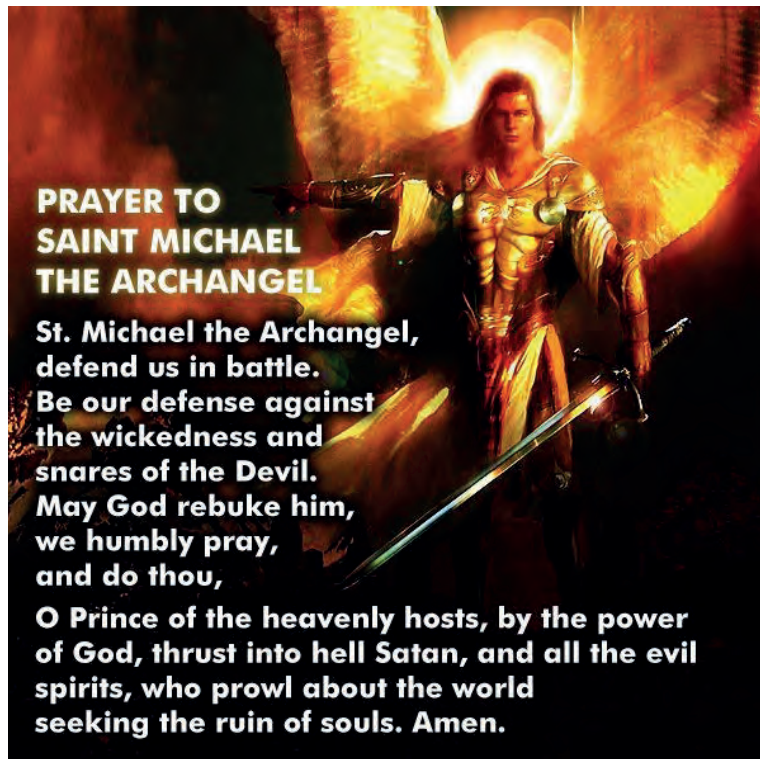


Take, O Lord, and receive all my liberty, my memory, my understanding, and my whole will.

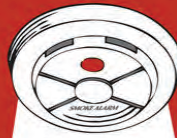
